<u>Brief Scope:</u> The purpose of the Agreement is to provide investment advisory services for the City's investments in accordance with the City's investment policy.			
<u>Justification:</u> Public Trust Advisors has provided investment management and advisory services for the City's investment portfolio based on the established investment policies. The Public Trust Advisors has been very professional and provided prompt and accurate information to concerns related to investment transactions. The firm has a system in place to make sure investments are followed as per the investment policy. Its expertise and professional approach have been very valuable to the City. The Finance Department has provided an excellent performance evaluation for Public Trust Advisors and recommends extending the term for an additional one (1) year period, as allowed in the Agreement.

<u>Brief Scope:</u> Use the correct scope.			
<u>Justification:</u> The Contractor has provided car wash services at the 17 th Street municipal parking garage as part of the Phase I of a pilot program, as stipulated in the Agreement. The pilot program consists of 5-10 spaces at the 17 th Street parking garage and for approximately six (6) months, with the intention that prior of the expiration of the pilot program, a report will be presented to the Finance and Citywide Projects Committee (FCWPC) for review. Following the review of said report, a recommendation will be then sent to the full City Commission for consideration. However, the Parking Department has not gathered sufficient data necessary to formulate a report to be presented at the FCWPC. Accordingly, the Parking Department is requesting to extend the current pilot program for an additional three (3) months to allow the Parking Department to present a report to the FCWPC, and a recommendation to the full Commission.
