
The Department of Transportation is aware of the proposed Pedestrian Bridge at approximately 5th Street and West Avenue in the City of Miami Beach. The Department has met with the development team and yourself to discuss the proposed Pedestrian Bridge.

The Department is aware that certain processes and actions are required for the City of Miami Beach to support and approve moving forward with the proposed Pedestrian Bridge. The Department as owner of the right-of-way and roadway composing 5th Street (State Route A1A) understands the development team must submit to the City for review within City processes to obtain approvals required to achieve City support and approvals for the proposed Pedestrian Bridge.

The Department has required processes and approvals that must be met before the proposed Pedestrian Bridge can move forward within our right-of-way. We will be unable to officially sign off on any documents associated with the proposed Pedestrian Bridge until the City support/approval is received and the Department processes and approvals are met.
