A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING, AS PART OF THE ACTIVATION OF SUPER BOWL LIV RELATED EVENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, THE EXTENSION OF HOURS UNTIL 7:00 A.M. ON JANUARY 30, 2020 THROUGH FEBRUARY 3, 2020, FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR CERTAIN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS WITH A 5:00 A.M. LIQUOR LICENSE, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 6-3(A)(6) OF THE CITY CODE; AND FURTHER, PROVIDING THAT THE EXTENSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SERVICE HOURS SHALL BE APPLIED ONLY TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS HOLDING SPECIAL EVENT PERMITS THAT ARE APPROVED BY THE CITY MANAGER.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach ("City") is an international tourist destination known for its many attributes including its vibrant nightlife; and

WHEREAS, the festivities during major event days and weekends in the City carry over into the early hours of the morning; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County will host Super Bowl LIV on February 2, 2020, with many related events taking place in the City of Miami Beach from January 30, 2020 through February 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the period from January 30, 2020 through February 3, 2020 will be a "major event period" pursuant to the City's Major Events Plan and Special Event Guidelines, attracting thousands of local, national and international tourists; and

WHEREAS, as part of the activation of Super Bowl related events, the Administration recommends, and the Mayor and City Commission desire to support, the extension of on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages until 7:00 a.m. on January 30, 2020 through February 3, 2020, for establishments with a 5:00 A.M. liquor license that are in good standing, meet all of the conditions and requirements set forth in Section 6-3(A)(6) of the City Code, and have obtained a City Special Event Permit; and

WHEREAS, in order to address the special circumstances for this type of celebration and during other major event days and weekends within the City of Miami Beach, the Mayor and City Commission codified, in Section 6-3(a)(6) of the City Code, an established policy of allowing alcoholic beverage establishments with a 5:00 A.M. liquor license to continue to sell and serve alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption until 7:00 A.M. during designated major event days or weekends, subject to those conditions set forth in Section 6-3(a)(6); and

WHEREAS, in previous years, the approval for the extension to sell and serve alcoholic beverages from 5 A.M. to 7 A.M. has been granted, by the City Commission, for major events such as New Year's Eve, Gay Pride, or a Super Bowl; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami Beach hereby approve, as part of the activation of Super Bowl LIV related events within the City of Miami Beach, the extension of hours until 7:00 A.M. on January 30, 2020 through February 3, 2020, for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages for certain alcoholic beverage establishments with a 5:00 A.M. liquor license, subject to the conditions specified in Section 6-3(A)(6) of the City Code; and further provide that the extension of alcoholic beverage service hours shall be applied only to alcoholic beverage establishments holding Special Event Permits that are approved by the City Manager.
