Dear Mr. Fink:

I hope that all is well. I am writing you due to the fact that the Florida Department of Transportation is planning a road improvement project on A1A/Collins Avenue. This project consists of the installation of mid-block pedestrian crossings with overhead Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) at three (3) locations along SR A1A/Collins Avenue within the City of Miami Beach boundaries, in Miami-Dade County. The crosswalks are to be located to the south of 36th Street, to the south of 83rd Street, and to the south of 87th Street.

The improvements are based on recommendations from technical memoranda prepared to evaluate pedestrian safety enhancements along the identified segments of Collins Avenue, initiated by multiple citizen requests. Additional improvements included in the project are ADA improvements and additional signage to complement the proposed crosswalk locations, milling and resurfacing of the existing pavement, updating the pavement markings to match current standards, and lighting enhancements.

In order to complete this project, the Florida Department of Transportation is requesting the donation of Permanent Easement Parcels 800, 801 and 802. The Florida Department of Transportation's Public Works Department has identified these

Parcels as being owned by The City of Miami Beach. Parcel 800 is south of 36th Street, Parcel 801 is south of 83rd Street and Parcel 802 is south of 87th Street.

Pursuant to Section 337.25, Florida Statutes, the Florida Department of Transportation (Department) may accept donations of any land. Please accept this request for the donation of the above referenced parcels to the Florida Department of Transportation.
