A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER TO REJECT ALL PROPOSALS RECEIVED, PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS (RFQ) 2020-002-WG, TO DESIGN, FURNISH AND INSTALL RESILIENT SIGNAGE.

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2019, the City Commission approved the issuance of Request for Qualifications (RFQ) No. 2020-002-WG, to Design, Furnish and Install Resilient Signage, and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2019, the RFQ was issued, and

WHEREAS, RFQ responses were due and received on November 20, 2019, and

WHEREAS, the RFQ resulted in the receipt of four (4) responses, including submissions from Abarcon, LLC; Nexus Alpha Low Power Systems, LLC; Pixelwarps, Inc.; and ASI Signage Innovations; and

WHEREAS, although the proposers each had strong background and experience with sign manufacturing and installation, the interactive content and graphic design component was less strong; and

WHEREAS, after the receipt of proposals, the Environment and Sustainability Department has decided to focus the initial stage of the project on graphic design, copy, and content, rather than on sign manufacturing; and

WHEREAS, after considering and reviewing staff's recommendation to first focus on graphic design and content, the City Manager has recommended that the Mayor and City Commission reject all proposals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager, to reject all proposals received, pursuant to Request for Qualifications No. 2020-002-WG, to Design, Furnish and Install Resilient Signage.
