Original Architects: Nadel and Nordin (1936)

M. J. Nadel, American architect from New Jersey. His initial work appeared documented in the book "The Lumber Manufacturer and Dealer", as a 1919 brick factory and loft building in NJ. Important Art Deco buildings are the Splendor (1924) and the Pennway Apartments (1939) in Miami Beach.

Robert M. Nordin, American architect from New Jersey. Member of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) from 1921-1925. He was an architect in Miami with outstanding Art Deco and Modernist buildings in the Miami Beach and Miami Shores area. Other important residences are in West Palm Beach and were built during the 1940s.

Architect for Addition: Henry Hohauser (1940)

Henry Hohauser (1895-1963) was an architect in Miami Beach, Florida. He is known for his Art Deco architecture stylings, and is listed as a "Great Floridian"; in 1993, he was ranked as one of the 100 most influential people in South Florida history by The Miami Herald.

Hohauser studied at the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn, New York before coming to Florida in 1932. Features of his work include symmetry on the front elevation, Art Deco stylings such as a ziggurat or stepped roofline, glass bricks, curved edges, and neon lighting.

Building Description: The Alden is a 3-story hotel building in the Art Deco style, designed by Architects Nadel and Nordin in 1936 and altered by Henry Hohauser in 1940. The original building and addition were built by J. Albert & Son.

During WWII the building was used by the military, and then returned to owner in 1945.

The original building was a concrete block structure with 52 rooms. An Otis elevator was one of its initial improvements.

The addition of 1940 added 18 more rooms and a basement area that was built on spread footing. It was also constructed with concrete block structure.

In 1952 the pool was added as a recreational facility of the hotel.

This building is an outstanding example of an asymmetrical Art Deco structure unique to the tropical environment of Miami Beach and very indicative of the period of significance. (Source: Miami Beach Historic Property Viewer).

The façade featured large casement windows with curved and angled projecting eyebrows and raised horizontal racing stripes. Stepped parapet accented by fluted panels and decorative relief. The same column fluted panel architecture is located on the right side of the structure, with two large columns and one small column.




