A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, PROVIDING A ONETIME ALLOCATION OF \$60,000.00 FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO PUBLIC SAFETY EFFORTS FOR EVENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE UPCOMING SUPER BOWL LIV ON FEBRUARY 2, 2020, DUE TO RECENT INCREASES IN THE ANTICIPATED CROWD VOLUME.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County has the special privilege of hosting Super Bowl LIV on February 2, 2020, which will take place at Hard Rock Stadium in Miami Gardens; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Lopez and Shakira will be co-headlining the Super Bowl halftime show, and Lady Gaga is set to headline AT&T TV Super Saturday Night on February 1, 2020, the day before the actual game at Island Gardens in Miami; and

WHEREAS, other National Football League-sanctioned events are scheduled throughout Miami-Dade County at venues like the Miami Beach Convention Center in the City of Miami Beach and Bayfront Park in the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, large events such as the Super Bowl, star-studded halftime performances, and other Super Bowl related activities spur significant crowd volumes, necessitating additional safety and security efforts, which are essential for an event of this magnitude.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby provide a onetime allocation of \$60,000.00 for expenses related to public safety efforts for events associated with the upcoming Super Bowl LIV on February 2, 2020, due to recent increases in the anticipated crowd volume.
