PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT Proposed Phase One Reopening Plan

Miami Dade County and Cities are preparing to initiate Phase One of Parks and Greenspace reopenings. These reopenings will include restrictions and modifications to park facilities, park uses and hours of operation. Not all park and greenspace facilities will reopen during phase one.

Areas to remain closed during phase one:

- Playgrounds
- Indoor Facilities
- Outdoor Exercise Equipment
- Picnic Areas / Picnicking
- Dog Parks
- Play Fields Staff needs a more specific definition of this from the County. This may close areas within our parks, not recommended for closure at this time.
- Skate Parks
- Pools
- Volleyball Courts
- Park Restrooms
- Fishing Piers
- Indoor 4 wall courts
- Basketball Courts

The above list, except for those in italics, are included in the proposed Miami Dade County Emergency Order. The City Miami Beach recommends being stricter by including the below in the list of closures.

- Park Restrooms except for Golf Course and Tennis Centers (These areas will be controlled by staff and strict social distancing and sanitizing will be followed.)
- Fishing Piers The South Pointe Park Pier is extremely popular, regulating social distancing on this pier is a challenge and opening the pier poses a greater health threat.
- Indoor Four Wall Courts -The County includes indoor facilities in the draft order but in an abundance of caution Miami Beach will include the four wall indoor courts at Flamingo Park in their list of restricted areas.
- Basketball Courts The County is proposing regulating 3 players per half court, with all players having their own basketball and no sharing or touching of the other persons basketball. This would be extremely difficult to enforce. Miami Beach will include the closure of basketball courts in their list of restricted areas.

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Additional Rules

- Park hours will be at a maximum of sunrise to sunset. The Parks and Recreation Department will provide a list of park hours by facility.
- Face masks must always be worn except while exercising (running, tennis play, golfing, etc.)
- Social distancing must be observed
- All pedestrian trails will be one -way
- Tennis is singles play only
- Racquetball is one player practicing skills only
- Community Garden is one gardener at a time.
- Groups of 10 or more are prohibited
- Parks are for limited short-term use by individuals and families for jogging, walking and biking. No organized activities, sports, classes, etc.
- Tennis Centers (FPTC and MBTC) restrooms open during operating hours per the following:

1 person allowed in men's and women's restroom at a time Staff to clean restroom after use

- Park entrance push bars, benches, trash/recycling cans, etc. sanitized at various times throughout the day
- Strict enforcement of social distancing measures, use of face masks, unauthorized activities such as pick-up games, fitness classes, commercial use activity, etc. will be implemented with penalties and fines

Additional Phase One Guidelines

- 1. Tennis Centers
 - a. Hours of operation 7am-7pm
 - b. Park Ranger and/or repurposed staff to assist with enforcement if needed
 - c. Singles play and 1-on-1 lessons to only occur at the courts
 - d. Court bookings to occur online and/or via phone.
 - e. Payments for courts to take place online or over the phone
 - f. Staff and Customers to wear face masks entering and exiting the facility
 - 1. Masks only to be removed once on the court before play
 - 2. Masks to be put back on once exiting courts and exiting facility
 - 3. Staff to wear gloves
 - f. Patrons to enter through the main door and exit after play through Court 1 or Court 14 exit at Flamingo Park Tennis Center
 - 1. MBTC players to exit through the facility heading North adjacent to Court 7
 - g. Once play is complete players must exit the facility
 - h. Markings on the floor so that tennis patrons adhere to social distancing guidelines
 - i. No coolers on the courts, no water fountains available, patrons to bring their own water bottles
 - j. No merchandise, drinks or stringing to occur
 - k. Inside and outside furniture to be removed from sites to prevent congregating at site
 - I. Hitting wall to be limited to one person at a time (30 minute max)
 - m. Facility staff to wipe down door handles and sanitize facility on an hourly basis
 - n. Facility to have directional signage for exit and entrance
 - o. Facility to communicate with tennis patrons regarding rules for current use
 - p. Regulated restroom use
 - g. Locker room use prohibited

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2. Neighborhood Tennis Courts

- a. Hours of operation: sunrise to sunset
- b. No commercial use
- c. Singles play only not to exceed one hour (unless no one is waiting for a court)
- d. Staff to assist with enforcement as needed

3. Flamingo Stadium / Track (Labor intensive implementation)

- a. Hours of operation: sunrise to sunset
- b. Park Ranger and/or repurposed staff to be stationed at the facility (2 Staff members one at the entrance, second walking around the facility) to assist with enforcement
- c. Masks to be worn while in the facility unless exercising, running, etc.
- d. No access to exercise equipment
- e. Individual exercise permitted only (no group exercise)
- f. No personal weights, exercise and/or training equipment (including bands, cones, punching bags, etc.)
- g. Run/jog/walk at your own risk in a counter clockwise position
- h. Users to be 6 feet apart while in the facility
- i. No organized activities and/or pick-up games to occur such as flag football, soccer, etc.
- j. Water fountains not accessible to be covered with a bag
- k. Restroom use prohibited
- I. Entrance and exit only to occur on 12th and Michigan
- m. Max Capacity not to exceed 20-30 people as long as social distancing is adhered to
 - 1. Markings on the floor at the entrance so social distancing guidelines are in place for those waiting to get into the facility
 - 2. One person in / one person out once maximum capacity is reached

3. Hand-Ball/Racquet ball Courts

- a. Hours of operation sunrise to sunset
- b. Outdoor courts only
- c. One person to a court
- d. Not to exceed 30 minute of use (unless no one is waiting for a court)
- e. Staff to assist with enforcement as needed

4. Batting Cage

- a. Hours of operation sunrise to sunset
- b. 1-to-1 in the cage
- c. No one permitted on the bleachers congregated
- d. Facial mask to be used while at the facility until entering batting cage
- e. No organized activity or commercial use permitted on the field or in the batting cage

5. Boat Ramp

- a. Hours 6:00am 8:00pm
- b. One boat in launch area at time
- c. Boats must be ready to enter and exit launch area quickly. No temporary docking will be permitted
