The Transportation, Parking and Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee met on Monday October 7th, 2019, and passed the below motions:

Electric Scooters

The Transportation, Parking and Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee supports micro-mobility for the City of Miami Beach and strongly recommends the below limitations:

- Limit to 3 companies
- Should not be ridden on sidewalks
- Use bike lanes where possible
- Users should be 16 or older
- Maximum speed of 15 mph
- Scooters are not to be left on private property
- Geo-fencing ability
- Explore option for liability insurance for riders

Better Bus Project

Transit Alliance provided a presentation regarding the Better Bus Project, which included different concepts. The Transportation, Parking and Bicycle-Pedestrian Facilities Committee recommends that the Mayor and City Commission support the MDC-Ridership Concept.
