Please note that Governor DeSantis' Executive Order Number 20-69, as extended by Executive Orders 20-121, 20-123, 20-139, 20-150, and 20-193, suspended the requirement of Section 112.286, Florida Statutes, the Florida Sunshine Law, that a quorum must be present in person, and that a local government body meet at a specific public place. The Executive Order also allows local government bodies to utilize communications media technology, such as telephonic and video conferencing for local government body meetings.

#### DR. STANLEY SUTNICK CITIZEN'S SPEAKERS FORUM

The times for the public comment period, known as the Dr. Stanley Sutnick Citizen's Forum, are 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter.
