BOARD AND COMMITTEES:

1. AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- A citizen actively engaged as a for-profit provider of affordable housing. (Category # 5)

2. ANIMAL WELFARE COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1).

- An individual who shall be recommended by the Miami Beach Animal Advocates Inc. and ratified by the City Commission. (Category 1)

3. DESIGN REVIEW BOARD

VACANCY (1):

- One landscape architect registered in the State of Florida. (To replace Marsh Kriplen, who resigned.)

4. HEALTH ADVISORY COMMITTEE

VACANCY (1):

- Ex-Officio, Miami-Dade County Health Department.

5. NEXT GENERATION COUNCIL

Note: Members must be eighteen (18) years through thirty-six (36) years of age at the time of appointment.

VACANCY (1).

- A member licensed and actively practicing in the field of architecture or engineering.

6. PERSONNEL BOARD

VACANCY (1).

- A citizen of Miami Beach not in the employment of the City, having a vocation different from any current Personnel Board member. (Excluded Vocations: Attorney; Translator; Psychotherapist; Real Estate; and Concert Producer/Impresario.)

7. SENIORS AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

VACANCIES (4):

- An individual selected by the Board of Directors of Jewish Community Services of South Florida. (Category # 1)
- A resident of the Blackstone Apartments who shall be recommended by the residents of the Blackstone Apartments and ratified by the City Commission. (Category # 4)
- A resident of Council Towers North who shall be recommended by the residents of Council Towers North and ratified by the City Commission. (Category # 7)
- A resident of Federation Towers who shall be recommended by the residents of Federation Towers and ratified by the City Commission. (Category # 9)
