A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER AND AUTHORIZING ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS, THE ADMINISTRATION TO PURSUANT TO REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI) NO. 2020-144-JC, FOR PRE AND POST-EMPLOYMENT MEDICAL SERVICES. WITH MOUNT SINAI MEDICAL CENTER OF FLORIDA, INC., FOR AN INITIAL PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS, WITH TWO (2) ONE (1) YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER, NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED ANNUALLY FOR THESE SERVICES THROUGH THE CITY'S BUDGETING PROCESS; AND FURTHER, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT UPON SUCCESSFUL NEGOTIATIONS BY CONCLUSION OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, the City utilizes medical services provider(s) to perform pre-employment physical examinations, drug and alcohol testing, fitness for duty evaluations, return-to-work evaluations, infectious disease exposure services, and administer vaccinations to City employees; and

WHEREAS, the City has an operational need to maintain local pre and post-employment medical services on a 24-hours a day, 365-days a year basis; and

WHEREAS, the current contract for pre and post-employment medical services with Mount Sinai Medical Center of Florida, Inc. (Mount Sinai), expired on February 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in anticipation of the expiring agreement, on January 15, 2020, the City Commission approved an extension of the agreement with Mount Sinai, on a month-to-month basis; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the expiring agreement, the Administration considered options for procuring future pre and post-employment medical services; and

WHEREAS, the Administration is aware that the City may exercise its discretion to procure medical services by way of the exemption of health services provided under Florida Statutes 287.057; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has determined that it is in the City's best interest to solicit information from firms providing pre and post-employment medical services; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to reveal available market options, Request for Information No. 2020-144-JC (the RFI) was issued on February 21, 2020, with an opening date of July 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City received a total of three (3) responses to the RFI from the following firms: Mount Sinai Medical Center of Florida, Inc.; Occupational Health Centers of the Southwest, PA dba Concentra Medical Centers; and Occupational Medical Centers of America; and

WHEREAS, Mount Sinai is the only respondent with facilities on Miami Beach; and

WHEREAS, Mount Sinai is the only respondent capable of meeting the City's local services needs operating on a 24-hours a day, 365-days a year basis; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has consistently rated Mount Sinai as highly satisfactory in the services provided to the City; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the submissions, the City Manager is recommending that the Mayor and City Commission approve this Resolution, authorizing the Administration to enter into negotiations with Mount Sinai Medical Center of Florida, Inc., as the firm most able to provide the pre and post-employment medical services, meeting the City's best interests.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager, and authorize the Administration to enter into negotiations, pursuant to Request for Information (RFI) No. 2020-144-JC, for Pre and Post-employment Medical Services, with Mount Sinai Medical Center of Florida, Inc., for an initial period of three (3) years, with two (2) one (1) year renewal options, at the sole discretion of the City Manager, not to exceed the amount appropriated annually for these services through the City's budgeting process; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement upon conclusion of successful negotiations by the Administration.
