

Parking ideas to save money.

Keep in mind all these restrictions started in 2016 the same year the department stopped having a surplus.

1. Bring full time parking officers and parking dispatchers back and keep the 21 PT officers positions frozen until parking finances improve. It will save the city approximate **\$830,000 a year.**
2. Have code pay for half of the dispatchers since parking dispatchers also dispatch code.
- 3 -Get rid of the overnight shift because there aren't enough calls after 2:30 am saving the city substantial amount of money.
- 4-Bring back the following citations which can potentially bring a lot of revenues again to the city.
