A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE CITY MANAGER, PURSUANT TO INVITATION TO NEGOTIATE NO. 2020-191-ND, FOR MANHOLE, STRUCTURES, AND CURED-IN PLACE REHABILITATION AND INSPECTION SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ENTER INTO SIMULTANEOUS NEGOTIATIONS WITH NATIONAL WATER MAIN CLEANING CO., AS THE TOP RANKED PROPOSER; VORTEX INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICES LLC, AS THE SECOND RANKED PROPOSER; AND ENVIROWASTE SERVICES GROUP, INC., AS THE THIRD RANKED PROPOSER; AND FURTHER PROVIDING THAT THE FINAL SELECTION AND APPROVAL OF A CONTRACT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PRIOR APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2020, the Mayor and City Commission authorized the issuance of Invitation to Negotiate (ITN) 2020-191-ND for Manhole, Structures, and Cured-In Place Rehabilitation and Inspection Services; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2020, the ITN 2020-191-ND for Manhole, Structures, and Cured-In Place Rehabilitation and Inspection Services (the "ITN") was issued; and

WHEREAS, a voluntary pre-proposal meeting for the ITN was held on June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2020, the City received a total of 8 proposals for the ITN; and

WHEREAS, the City received proposals in response to the ITN from the following eight (8) firms:

1. BLD Services, LLC;
2. Envirowaste Services Group, Inc.;
3. Granite Inliner, LLC;
4. Hinterland Group, Inc.
5. Insituform Technologies, Inc.;
6. Miller Pipeline, LLC;
7. National Water Main Cleaning Co.; and
8. Vortex Infrastructure Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the proposals from Insituform Technologies, Inc. and Miller Pipeline, LLC were deemed non-responsive for failure to meet the minimum qualifications requirements of the ITN and were not considered further; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2020, via LTC # 269-2020, the City Manager appointed the Evaluation Committee (the "Committee") to review the ITN; and

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2020, the Committee convened to review and score the responsive proposals to the ITN; and

WHEREAS, the Committee was provided an overview of the ITN, information relative to the City's Cone of Silence Ordinance and the Government Sunshine Law, general information on the scope of services, and a copy of each proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Committee was instructed to score and rank each proposal pursuant to the evaluation criteria established in the ITN; and

WHEREAS, the Committee's evaluation process resulted in the ranking of proposers as follows: National Water Main Cleaning Co., as the top ranked proposer; Vortex Infrastructure Services, LLC, as the second ranked proposer; Envirowaste Services Group, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; Granite Inliner, LLC, as the fourth ranked proposer; Hinterland Group, Inc. as the fifth ranked proposer; and BLD Services LLC, as the sixth ranked proposer; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing all of the submissions and the Committee's rankings and commentary, the City Manager agrees with the Committee and recommends that the Mayor and City Commission authorize the Administration to enter into simultaneous negotiations with National Water Main Cleaning, Co., as the top ranked proposer; Vortex Infrastructure Services, LLC, as the second ranked proposer; and Envirowaste Services Group, Inc., as the third ranked proposer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the City Manager, pursuant to Invitation to Negotiate No. 2020-191-ND, for Manhole, Structures, and Cured-In Place Rehabilitation and Inspection Services, and authorizes the Administration to enter into simultaneous negotiations with National Water Main Cleaning, Co., as the top ranked proposer; Vortex Infrastructure Services, LLC, as the second ranked proposer; and Envirowaste Services Group, Inc., as the third ranked proposer; and further providing that the final selection and approval of a contract shall be subject to the prior approval of the Mayor and City Commission.
