
Dear Mayor and City Commissioners:

We are writing to respectfully request that the City consider the deployment of IKE kiosks throughout its public rights-of-way. By way of background, in 2017, IKE received the City Manager's recommendation for award in connection with a procurement for Interactive Digital Media Kiosks. However, at that time, the Commission decided not to proceed to see how kiosk technology evolved. Since then, IKE has installed several interactive kiosks in Coral Gables, and was recently awarded the right to install over 100 kiosks throughout Miami. IKE is also live in 7 additional cities, including Baltimore, Cleveland, Columbus, San Antonio, Denver, St. Louis, and Tempe, and is in various stages of deployment in approximately 11 more cities.

We believe now is a good time for Miami Beach to launch a cohesive wayfinding kiosk network connecting the Miami Beach area, and to use IKE as an effective tool during the COVID-19 crisis to disseminate critical emergency information and promote local small businesses. Importantly, if permitted to install at least 30 kiosks, we will make an upfront pre-payment to the City of \$1,000,000, which we will recover from future advertising revenues. In summary, we propose the following:

- We will manufacture, install, operate and maintain at least 30 kiosks at no cost to the City;
- Within 45 days of contract execution and entitlement, we will make an upfront nonrefundable pre-payment of \$1,000,000, which we will recover from future advertising revenue; and,
- After kiosks are installed, IKE will share 40% of net revenues with the City. Under the proposed contract, the City is projected to receive between \$1,500,000 and \$2,000,000 annually, and between \$30,000,000 and \$40,000,000 across 30 kiosks over the 20-year term.

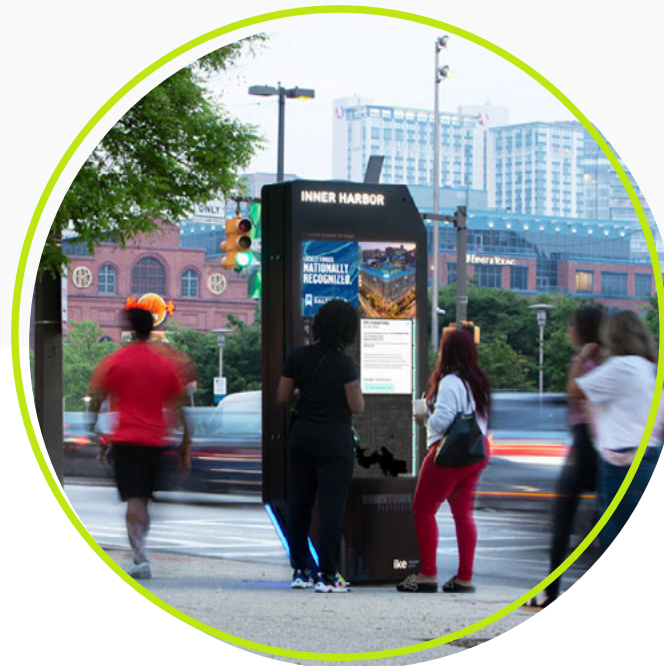
Platform

IKE's technology delivers intuitive usability for citizens while focusing on platform objectives that maximize the ability to provide information and services for the community.



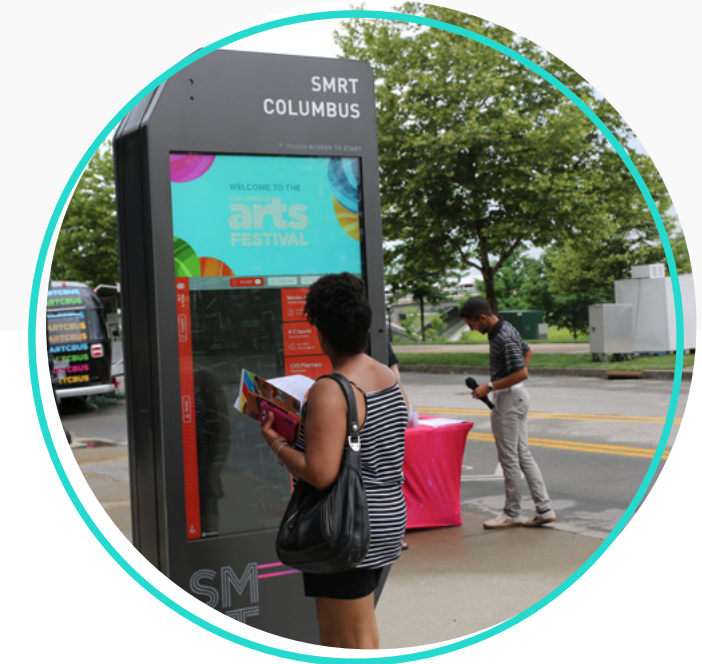
FLEXIBLE SOFTWARE

Our software adapts based on the overall needs of our partners or new technologies, and the platform is built with flexibility in mind. This flexibility includes IKE's infrastructure, scalable back-end systems, beautifully-designed user interfaces, and integration with third-party services and data.



SEAMLESS INTEGRATION

IKE displays the most up-to-date information by building our software on an open data platform that integrates with city data sources and other third-party providers. IKE's standard integrations include comprehensive, geo-filtered descriptions for points-of-interest, while additional integrations drive transit information, and merge city data into the platform.



CONTINUOUS EVOLUTION

Hardware

Digital Ticker

IKE’s digital ticker provides additional wayfinding with a design aesthetic that reflects traditional public transit cues. The LED strip is located at the top of the kiosk to maximize visibility for pedestrians and vehicular traffic. With different options for content, the ticker can be remotely programmed to scroll or display customized information, including:

- Street names or landmark identifiers
- Transit information like real-time bus schedules
- PSAs or alerts from the City
- News headlines or important updates

This space is dedicated to community-related content and advertisers cannot pay to be in the ticker.



Customization

IKE reserves real estate for clients to brand the kiosk both on and off screen. The most effective kiosks balance a clean and appealing aesthetic with an inviting and engaging user experience.

- **BRANDING**

Client's choice of logo or text branding will be applied to the upper corner of both faces of the kiosk. Custom ad panels can be created to welcome residents and visitors to the area, with unique executions by neighborhood.

- **KINETIC LIGHTING**

Clients can choose from a palette of base light colors to complement their brand and city aesthetics. Colors can be changed to celebrate holidays, events, and more (i.e. pink for Breast Cancer Awareness Month, orange for Halloween).

- **CONTENT**

A customizable geofence ensures that content is specific to the areas around each kiosk location.



Modes of Operation

IKE has two modes of operation, allowing for an engaging mix of both interactive and commercial content.



PASSIVE MODE

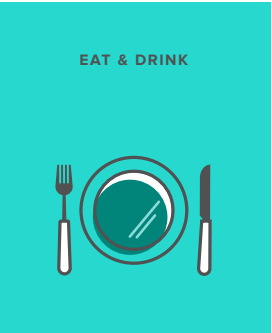
This is the default mode of operation when a pedestrian has not engaged with IKE’s interactive features. The entire screen is occupied by a 9:16 portrait layout showing an ad loop of city, community, arts, and commercial messaging.



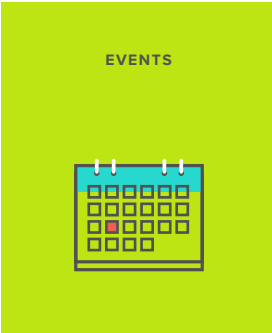
ENGAGED MODE

Once a pedestrian touches IKE’s screen, the interactive user experience is launched. In Engaged Mode, the application dashboard displays on the bottom two-thirds of the screen, and the ad loop is resized to a 16:9 landscape layout at the top of the screen.

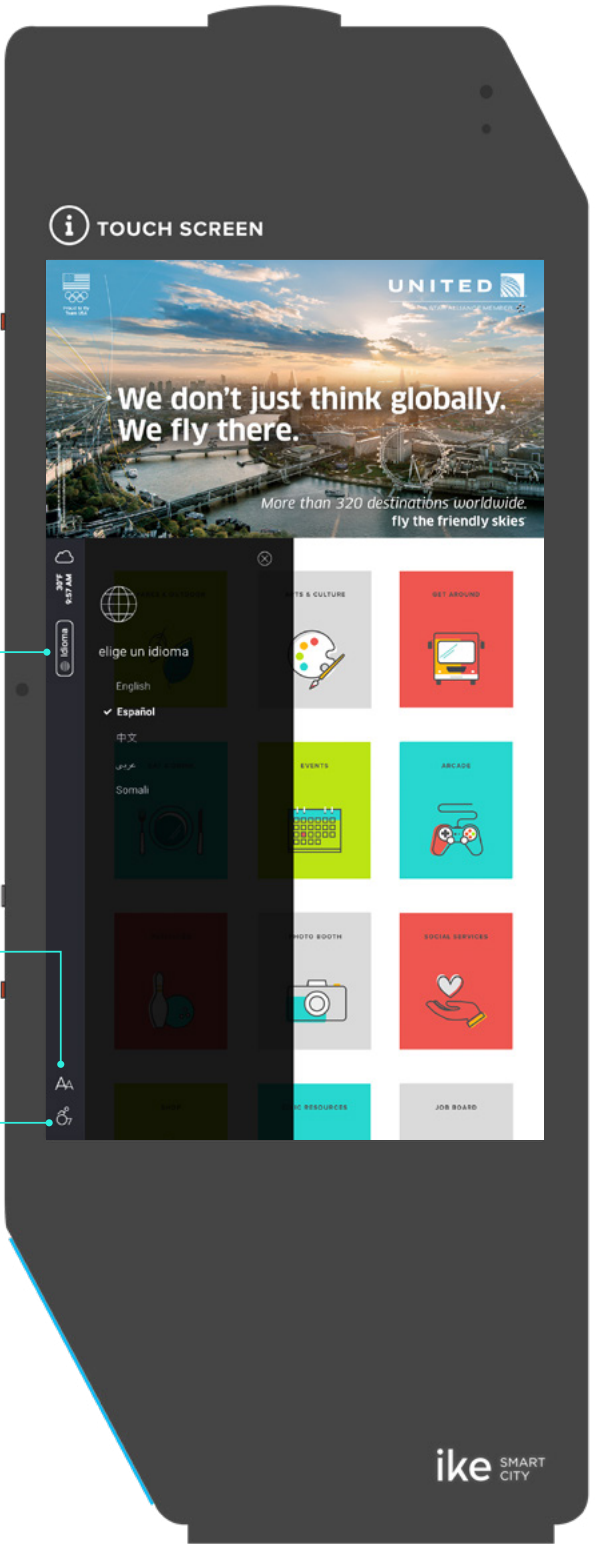
ADA

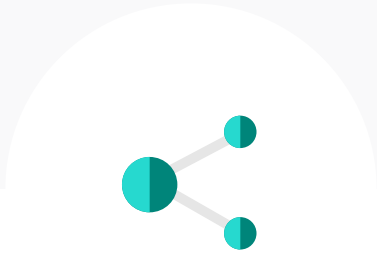
