- 87th Street
- North Shore Open Space Park
- North Shore Youth Center
- 73rd & Ocean Terrace
- Fire Station #2
- Fire Staton #3

To date, the City has spent the following amounts, by year, for the purchase installation, and refurbishment of the aforementioned decorations:

- FY 2018 \$435,440.28
- FY 2019 \$535,440.28
- FY 2020 \$894,257.51
- FY 2021 \$496,762.00

Currently, the Procurement Department has issued RFQ 2021-083-WG in order to solicit firms to design, furnish, install, maintain, remove, and store holiday lighting decorations.
