SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS THE 2021/2022 HOLIDAY LIGHTING PROGRAM CITYWIDE.

#### BACKGROUND

On January 28, 2021, the Neighborhood and Quality of Life Committee (NQLC) held a discussion on the Holiday Lighting programs citywide. The NQLC passed a motion to maintain the current service level of holiday lighting and décor at \$594,000.00 per year. The Committee directed the Property Management Department to research the feasibility of installing permanent lighting on Collins Avenue between 46<sup>th</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### **ANALYSIS**

At the request of the Committee, the Department has obtained an initial estimate of \$1.2 million in order to install permanent lighting on the palm trees on Collins Avenue between 46<sup>th</sup> and 64<sup>th</sup> Street. This cost includes infrastructure, equipment, and monthly maintenance. The cost is broken down as follows:

- Infrastructure \$159,000.00
- Equipment \$990,000.00
- Maintenance \$23,000.00 yearly

#### CONCLUSION

The Department seeks the recommendation of the Neighborhoods and Quality of Life Committee for the installation of the lighting in the proposed areas.
