SUBJECT: Mayor's 41st Street Blue Ribbon Committee Motions

The purpose of this Letter to the Commission ("LTC") is to provide an update regarding approved motions made during the January 28, 2021 and February 25, 2021 meetings of the Mayor's 41st Street Blue Ribbon Committee.

**Background:** The Mayor's 41<sup>st</sup> Street Blue Ribbon Committee recently requested that the Administration utilize Quality of Life funds to support 41<sup>st</sup> Street restaurants in participating in the Restaurant Recovery Outdoor Seating Pilot Program. The Administration has taken steps to facilitate the Program for an initial 90-day period per participating restaurant. The Committee has also discussed the potential for a Business Improvement District (BID) to be formed, particularly after the 41<sup>st</sup> Street Committee has sunset.

## January 28, 2021 meeting

 Motion 1: That the 41<sup>st</sup> Street Committee continue the outdoor seating pilot program for restaurants on 41<sup>st</sup> Street in perpetuity; so long as the restaurant operators will work out the financial considerations after the 90-day period has expired.
