Side Setback Variances, Pool Setback Variance, and Height Variance for a New Single-Family Home- Vitaly Pinchuk ("Applicant")

318 Atlantic Avenue

Public Hearing #: PZ2021-03

Summary: The Applican), owner of a property, is seeking approval for four variances in relation to the new construction of a single-family home. The variances being requested are (1) a side selback variance for the east side of the property, (2) a side selback variance for the west side of the property. (3) a pool side selback variance on the east side, and (4) a height variance for a new single-family home on an existing lot of record.

Requests:

- Pursuant to Sections 265-31 of the City of Sunny Isles Beach Land Development Regulations, the nt is requesting a side setback variance to decrease the required side setback from seven and half feet (7.5') to five feet (5') on the east side of the property.
- Pursuant to Sections 265-31 of the City of Sunny isles Beach Land Development Regulations, the applicant is requesting a side setback variance to decrease the required side setback from seven and halt feet (7.5') to five teet (5') on the west side of the property.
- Pursuant to Sections 265-31 and 265-45(I) of the City of Suppy Isles Beach Land Development Regulations, the applicant is also requesting a pool side setback variance to decrease the required po-side selback from nine and half feet (9.5') to seven and half teel (7.5') on the east side of the property.
- Pursuant to Sections 265-31 of the City of Sunny Isles Beach Land Development Regulations, applicant is requesting a height variance to increase the required height by an additional four feet a inches (4'-10") to not exceed thirty-nine teet and ten inches (39'-10"), where the required height is thirtyfive (35') feet and measured from the crown of the road.

The plans are entitled "Pinchuk Residence- New House", by Bruce & Bruce, stamped received March 23rd, 2021 and March 29, 2021 consisting of 19 sheets, including survey prepared by Landlec Surveying, stamped received March 23rd, 2021.
