The Education Foundation provides educational opportunities by offering scholarships and grants to students and teachers as well as access to medical attention and mental health counseling in our 8 Miami Beach feeder pattern public schools.

To identify and support the needs of public education in Miami Beach and its feeder pattern schools.

Programs

IB Program

The International Baccalaureate (IB) program is available at all the public schools in the City of Miami Beach feeder pattern to help develop the intellectual, personal, emotional and social skills of students ages 3 to 19 and gives them the necessary tools to live, learn and work in a rapidly globalizing world. Proceeds from the Chamber's Annual Golf Tournament have funded over \$200,000 worth of programming costs for the (IB) program throughout the years.

Healthcare

The Foundation has built an incredible coalition of support for a healthcare program within each of the eight schools in our Miami Beach feeder pattern to provide a school nurse, a full-time assistant and a social worker for each school. We have earned the support from all five cities: Miami Beach, North Bay Village, Surfside, Bay Harbor Island, and Bal Harbour.

Scholarships

The Miami Beach Chamber Education Foundation raises funds to reinvest in public education, where we feel the greatest return can be found. We provide college scholarships to deserving seniors of Miami Beach Senior High each year and provide the 10,000 school age children in our community the benefits of a wellness program so they can stay in school and concentrate on learning.



Links – Teachers Grants Initiative

We provide as many as three teachers' grants of up to \$1,000 a piece in each of the eight public schools that are part of the Miami Beach public school feeder pattern.

We call this the "Links Project" as it demonstrates the "linkage" between the business community, from whom we raise the funds, and public education.
