## Restrictions Aimco agreed to with Wavna: All violated

- Below is a list of restrictions which culminated in the Aimco project winning the support of the Wavna. Those restrictions called a Design Review Order were:
- Hours of operation 10:30pm weekdays and midnight weekends
- Music at ambient volume only
- Entertainment prohibited (in the city municode "entertainment" is defined as live music, live DJ, cooking classes)
- Special event permits prohibited

The purpose of the restrictions is to allow residents quiet enjoyment inside their homes. Flamingo Point is in a residential zone (called RM-3) and across the street from a low intensity residential zone called RM-1. Restaurants in commercial zones, such as Alton Road, have more leeway.

## What the community demands

- Before considering any further proposals from Aimco:
- 1. Require they meet with the local community groups:
  - Wavna
  - MBU
  - South Tower Community
- 2. Because we are in the midst of summer, require a meeting sometime in early fall (so members away on vacation will have time to return, meet and plan)
- 3. Allow the parties to come to a written agreement of understanding, that Aimco and the community groups listed above, can present to the DRB
- 4. **Then, and only then**, entertain any further requests from Aimco
