AN OROINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, SUBPART B, ENTITLED "LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS," BY AMENDING CHAPTER 142 OF THE CITY CODE ENTITLED "ZONING DISTRICTS AND REGULATIONS," ARTICLE V, ENTITLED "SPECIALIZED USE REGULATIONS," DIVISION 10, ENTITLED "PS CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES REGULATIONS AND USE." BY AMENDING SECTION 142-1502, ENTITLED "ZONING DISTRICTS ALLOWING MEDICAL CANNABIS TREATMENT CENTERS, PHARMACY STORES, AND RELATEO USES, PROHIBITED LOCATIONS, AND NONCONFORMING USES," TO CREATE A NEW AREA WHERE SUCH USES MAY 8E PERMITTEO, PROVIDED THAT THE PROPOSED USE MEETS CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, AND PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. The entrance to the City Hall Garage is located on 18th Street between Meridian Avenue and Convention Center Drive.

A SECURE VITE-RY-MAIL OROP BOX WILL BE STAFFED BY AN EARLY VOTING STAFF MEMBER FOR THE DAYS AND HOURS EARLY VOTING IS AVAILABLE. You do not even have to go inside! Vote-by-Mail ballots can be dropped into a secure Ballot Drop Box located outside any of the two Miami Beach Early Voting locations. Drop boxes are drive-up and are safe.

When voting at any voting location, whether it is Early Voting or Election Day, be sure to bring a current and valid identification that contains your name, photograph, and signature. While it is not required that you bring your Voter Information Card to the polling place, it will expedite your check-in process.

In order to be eligible to vote in the November 2, 2021 City of Miami Beach General and Special Elections, you must be registered to vote with the Miami-Dade County Elections Department by 5:00 p.m. on October 4 2021

Registered voters who choose to vote on Election Day must vote at their assigned polling place.
