“ The passing of Dr. Morris Sunshine at the age of 97 last month was a great loss for his family and friends and all of us who admired his tireless civic contribution to the City of Miami Beach. Dr. Sunshine represented the best of the greatest generation, flying 35 missions in World War II, manning the 50-caliber machine gun in the waist turret of the B-17 Flying Fortress on missions over Nazi Germany.

His involvement as a resident in the affairs of the City of Miami Beach helped to shape many City policies and ordinances over the years. Perhaps the best example of his service to the City is the thirty plus years he served as Chairman and/or Board Member of what would become the Marine and Waterfront Protection Authority Board.

I had the privilege of appointing Dr. Sunshine as my representative for his most recent term as a member of the Marine and Waterfront Protection Authority Board.

As discussed at the October monthly meeting of the Marine and Waterfront Protection Authority Board, (please see attached agenda), the Board has recommended commemorating the legacy of Dr. Sunshine by naming the recently installed floating dock, for use exclusively by non-motorized vessels, as located at Maurice Gibb Park, in his honor. Constructed at a cost of approximately \$780,000 and opened for public use a mere two years ago, Dr. Sunshine vigorously supported efforts of City staff in concert with the efforts of the MWPA Board to realize this incredible City amenity.

There is no better location from which to launch for a paddleboarding or kayaking adventure than “The Sunshine Dock” or “The Dr. Morris Sunshine Dock” for the residents and visitors of Miami Beach.

It is therefore requested that the members of the Neighborhood and Quality of Life Committee consider this matter as an agenda item at your October 2021 meeting.”
