A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE CERTIFICATE OF THE RESULTS OF THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH.

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, a Canvassing Board was appointed and authorized to canvass the City of Miami Beach's November 2, 2021 General Election which was duly conducted by the Elections Department of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the results of the November 2, 2021 General Election have been certified by the Miami Beach Canvassing Board; and

WHEREAS, the candidates for Mayor and for City Commissioner in Groups I and III of the City of Miami Beach have received the number of votes cast as reflected more specifically within the Certificate of election results attached hereto as Composite Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.¹

WHEREAS, with regard to City Commission Groups I and III, no candidate received a majority of the votes cast as required by Sec. 2.01 of the City Charter; therefore, a Run-off Election will be held on November 16, 2021, as authorized by Resolution No. 2021-31763, and early voting therefor shall be conducted as provided by Resolution No. 2021-31764;

WHEREAS, the Run-off Election results for City Commissioner Group I and III will be adopted by the Miami Beach City Commission on November 22, 2021, followed by the swearing-in of all the newly-elected officials.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Miami Beach Canvassing Board having canvassed the returns of the November 2, 2021 General Election of the City of Miami Beach, the Mayor and City Commission hereby adopt the attached Certificate of the results of said General Election and it is hereby ordered that the Certificate of election results and this Resolution be recorded in the minutes of the November 5, 2021 City Commission meeting as a permanent record of the results of the November 2, 2021 General Election.
