A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE, UPON REQUEST OF EITHER THE MAYOR OR ANY MEMBER OF THE CITY COMMISSION, A LIST OF ALL DATABASES AND CATEGORIES OF DATA UTILIZED BY THE MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CODE COMPLIANCE DEPARTMENT, IN ORDER TO ASSIST THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION IN MAKING EFFECTIVE, INFORMED, DATA-SUPPORTED DECISIONS.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the City Charter, the City Commission is vested with all municipal powers of the City except those powers specifically delegated to the Mayor, the City Manager, the City Attorney, the Inspector General, the City Clerk, and the electors of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, as the governing body for the City, the City Commission's powers are broad, including policy-making relating to City matters and City departments, as well as appropriation authority and budget oversight to ensure that taxpayer resources are allocated and used efficiently; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 9, 2020, the Mayor and City Commission adopted Resolution No. 2020-31528, requiring the Administration to provide Miami Beach elected officials with access to all City-collected data in a timely manner, to promote good governance and informed decision-making; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission and all City employees, including employees of the Miami Beach Police Department and the Code Compliance Department, share the same obligation under Florida law to safeguard the confidentiality of exempt information maintained by the City and its departments, in order to promote public safety and the protection of the City's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, although this Resolution does not seek any underlying data itself, the Mayor and City Commission acknowledge that the Miami Beach Police Department and/or Code Compliance maintain certain sensitive or protected information, including, without limitation, security, infrastructure, investigative, and/or intelligence information which is confidential and exempt from public disclosure under Florida law; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is not intended to divulge any of the sensitive or protected data or compromise vital departmental functions and/or put crime victim, witness, informant or City employee safety or well-being in jeopardy, as the purpose of this Resolution is to require the Administration to provide a list of databases and categories of data maintained by the Police Department and Code Compliance Department, upon request, in order to permit the Mayor and City Commission to better understand and assess departmental operations, functions, and/or opportunities to improve the efficient utilization of resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the Administration to provide, upon request of either the Mayor or any member of the City Commission, a list of all databases and categories of data utilized by the Miami Beach Police Department and Code Compliance Department, in order to assist the Mayor and City Commission in making effective, informed, data-supported decisions.
