SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD AND QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS THE SURVEY CONDUCTED OF MIAMI BEACH RESIDENTS REGARDING CRIME LEVELS IN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Miami Beach-based e.pluribus.US conducted a survey of Miami Beach residents in October 2021 to understand their degree of concern over crime levels and what specific causes they blamed for the situation. Almost 80% responded that they viewed crime levels as a serious current problem, then further articulated which of nine separate causes they saw as most responsible, as reported in the official results.

e.pluribus.us is a non-profit initiative to overcome the divisive partisanship frustrating the nation from getting things done. This survey is part of Project LISTEN, a tool under development to scalably understand the rationales behind opposing viewpoints.
