SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 90, ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE," BY AMENDING ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED "PRIVATE WASTE CONTRACTORS," BY AMENDING DIVISION 4, ENTITLED "SPECIALTY CONTRACTORS," BY AMENDING SUBDIVISION II, ENTITLED "ROLLOFF/PORTABLE WASTE CONTAINER CONTRACTORS," BY AMENDING SECTION 90-276 THEREOF, TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT FOR ANNUAL ROLLOFF PERMIT FEES TO REFLECT INCREASES IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance has been submitted by Commissioner Mark Samuelian for consideration at first reading by the Mayor and City Commission at the May 4, 2022 City Commission meeting.

On December 8, 2021, the Mayor and City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2021-4456, establishing an annual rolloff permit fee in the amount of \$1,000.00 to offset the City's administrative and processing costs.

The City Administration recommended amending the language in Section 90-276(2) to provide for annual administrative adjustment to the annual fee to reflect increases in the Consumer Price Index ("CPI") for the Miami-Fort Lauderdale-West Palm Beach, Florida area, pursuant to Section 1-15(b) of the City Code. If adopted, this amendment will allow the City Administration to consistently apply the same CPI moving forward.
