SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND NEIGHBORHOOD QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS THE ADDITION OF TWO MORE STOP SIGNS IN THE VICINITY OF WEST 46TH STREET AND ROYAL PALM AVENUE, TO CREATE A 4 WAY STOP SIGN CONFIGURATION IN ORDER TO IMPROVE VEHICULAR AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

ANALYSIS

Please place on the May 4, 2022 City Commission agenda a referral to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee to discuss concerns raised by residents regarding potentially hazardous traffic conditions in the vicinity of West 46th Street and Royal Palm Avenue, and the proposed placement of two additional stop signs, in order to better regulate northbound and southbound traffic and create a four way stop configuration.

As part of the referral, I would request the City Administration be prepared to discuss at the Committee its traffic analysis and the feasibility regarding the implementation of the proposed four way stop configuration.
