SECOND FLOOR PLAN

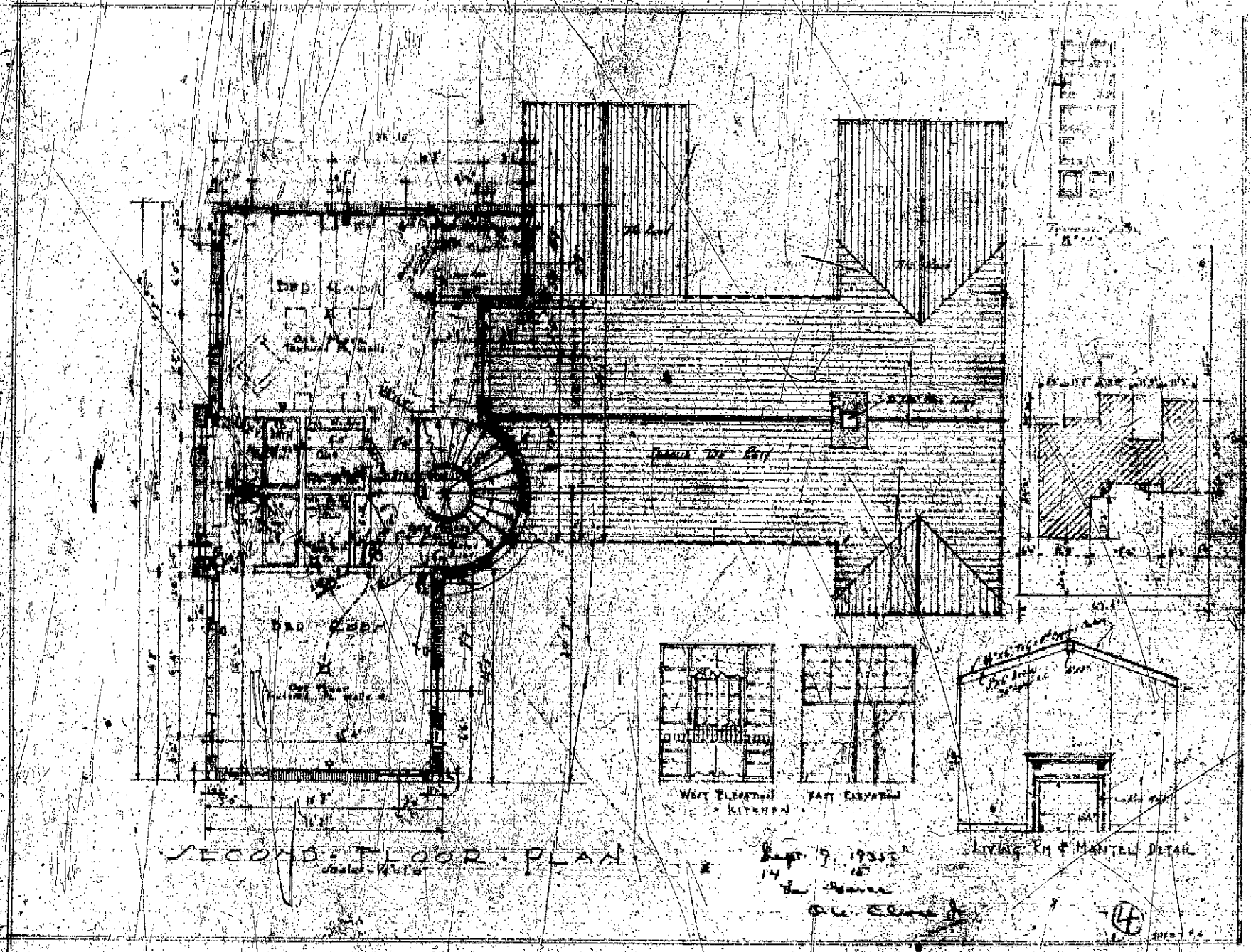

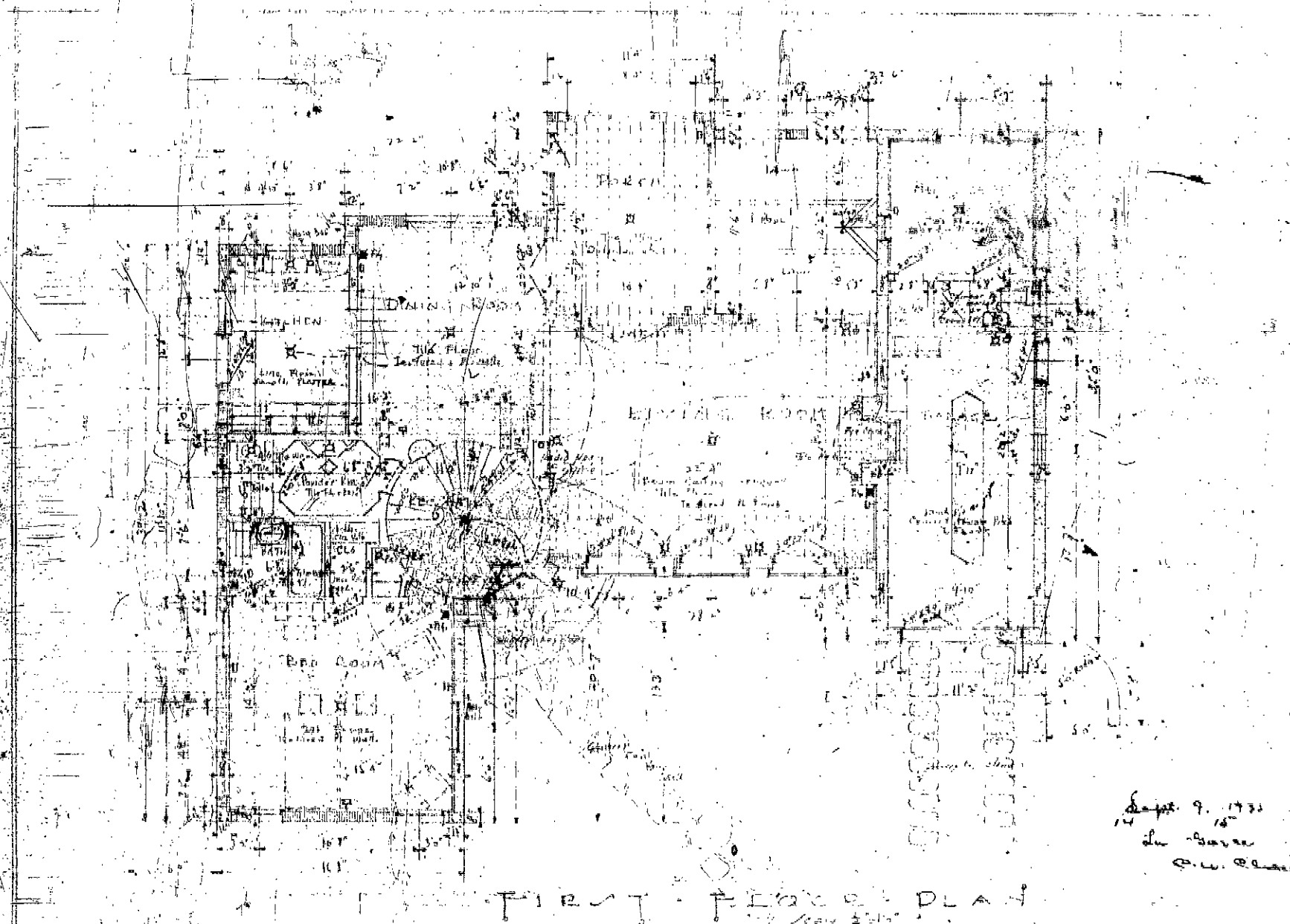


SECOND FLOOR PLAN

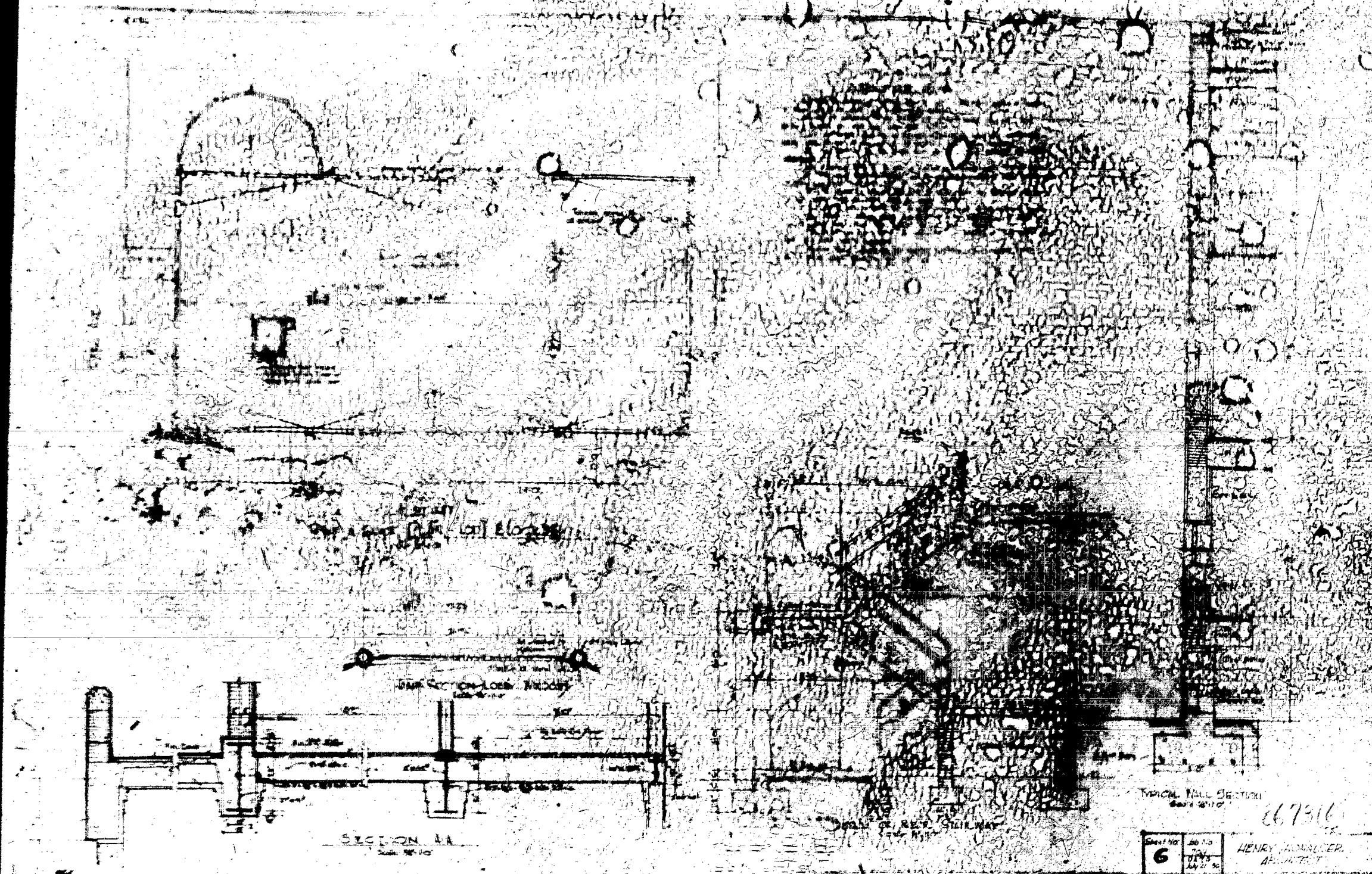


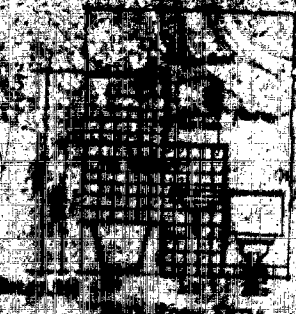
FIRST FLOOR PLAN

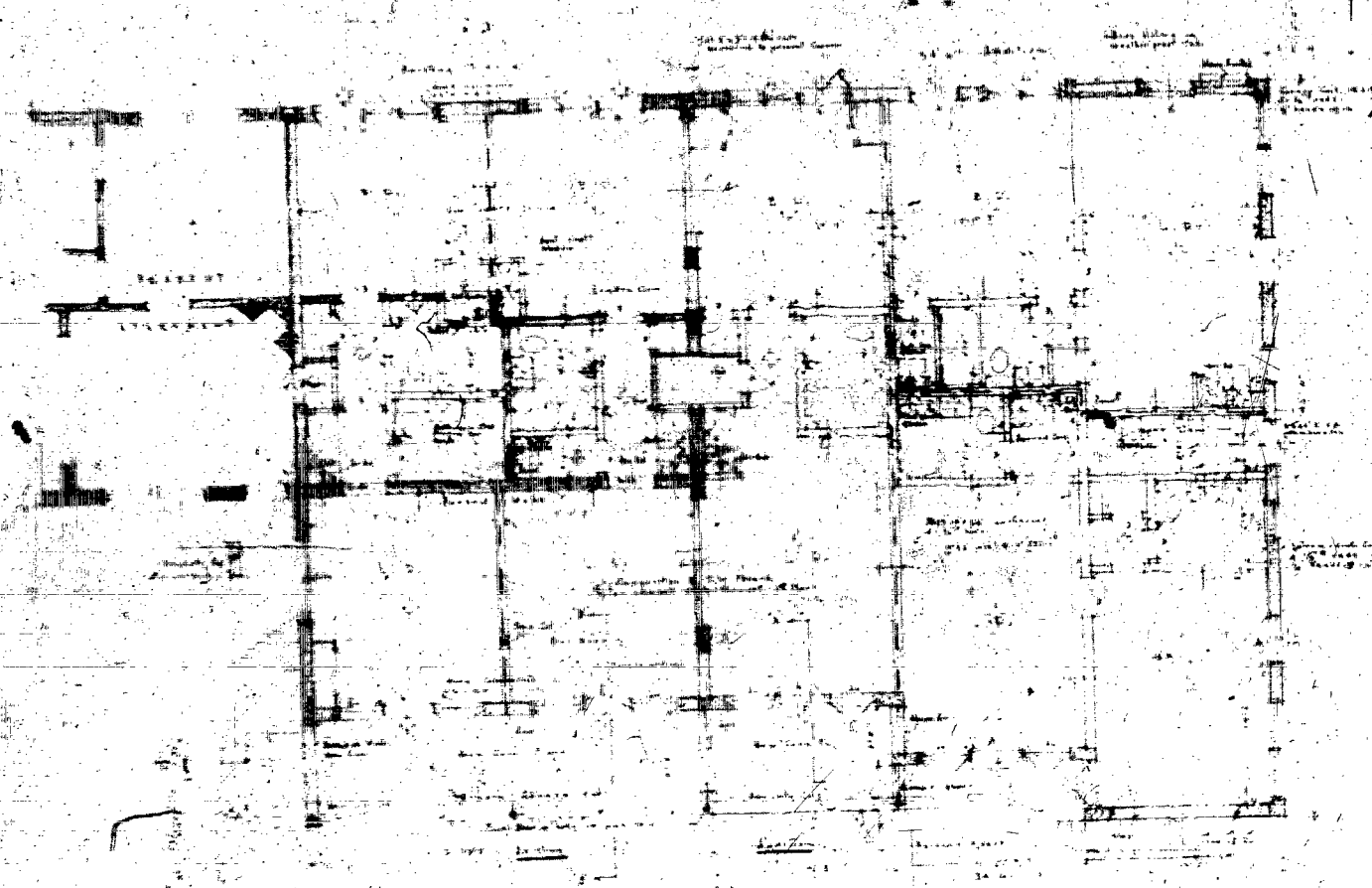


FOUNDATION & FOOTING PLAN



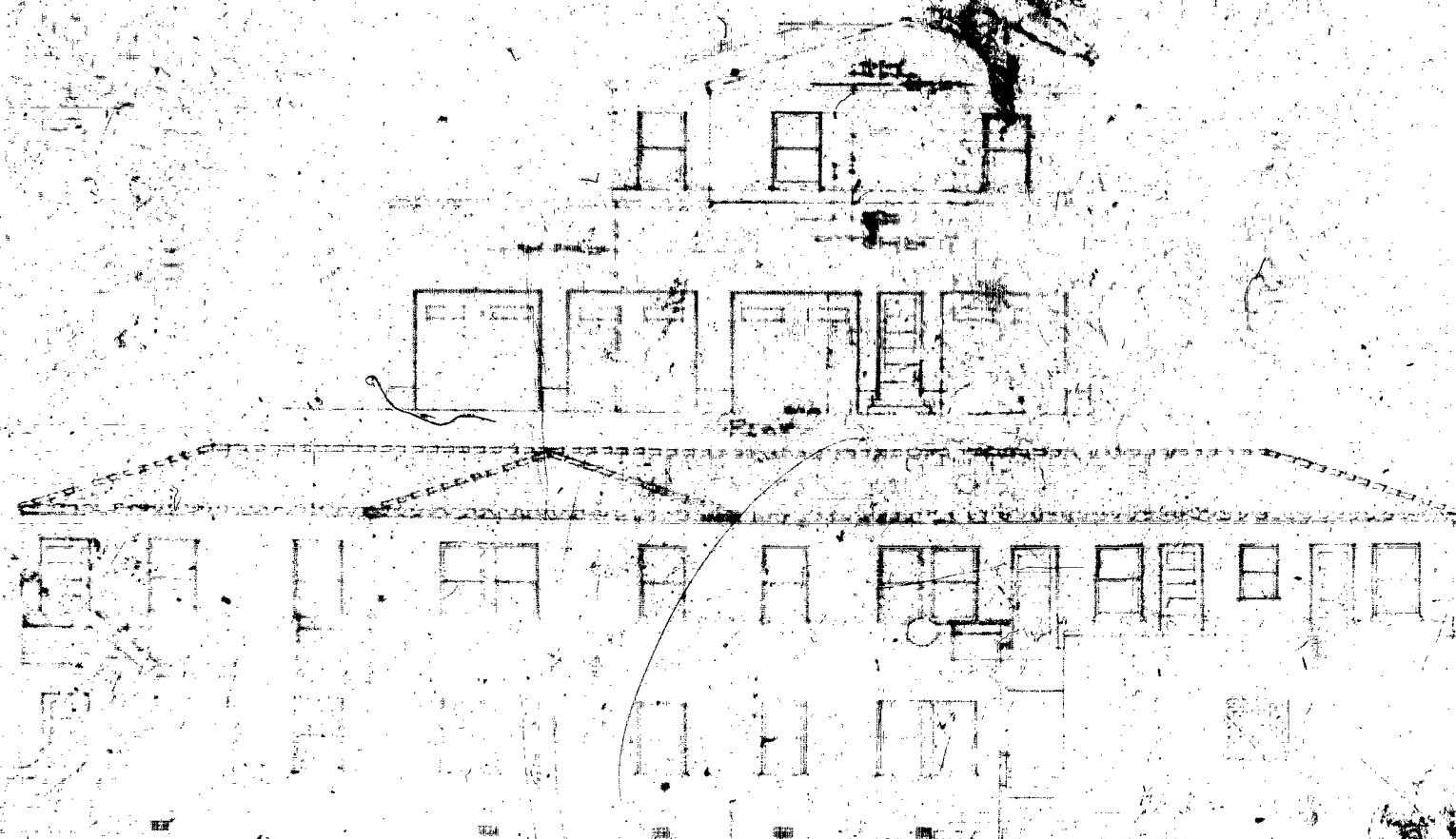

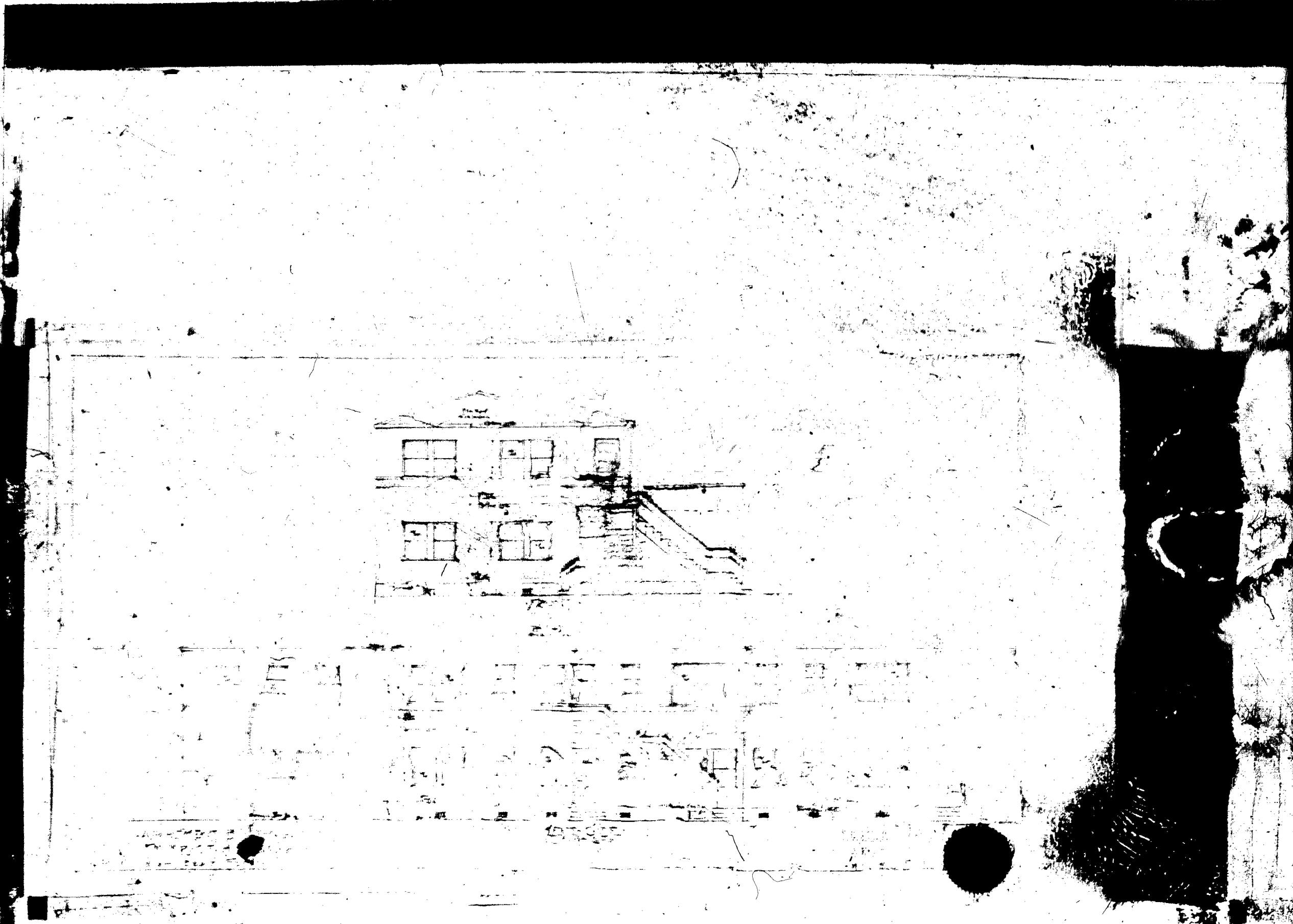




WATERMOUNT BUILDING
