A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING THE FINAL AD VALOREM MILLAGE RATE OF 0.9717 MILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 FOR THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, WHICH IS NINE AND SIX TENTHS PERCENT (9.6%) MORE THAN THE "ROLLED-BACK" RATE OF 0.8864 MILLS.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of providing security services within the Normandy Shores neighborhood area, the Mayor and City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 93-2881 on October 20, 1993, which authorized the creation of the Normandy Shores Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, specifies the method by which municipalities may establish the operating millage rate and adopt an annual budget for dependent taxing districts; and

WHEREAS, the maximum millage that can be approved by a majority (4/7th) vote is 0.9407 mills, anything beyond this rate, up to 1.0348 mills, requires a two-thirds (5/7th) vote, and a unanimous approval is required to approve a millage rate above 1.0348 mills for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023; and

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2022, the City Commission, acting as the Board of Directors of the District, adopted Resolution No. 2022-32253 which set the proposed operating millage rate of the District at 0.9717 mills for the purpose of providing security services within the District for FY 2023; and

WHEREAS, at the first public hearing on September 14, 2022, in accordance with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the Mayor and City Commission, acting as the Board of Directors of the District, tentatively adopted the operating millage for the District of 0.9717 mills for FY 2023; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2022, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the City Commission, acting as the Board of Directors of the District, held its first duly noticed public hearing to consider the Tentative Ad Valorem Millage and Tentative Operating Budget for the District for FY 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT that, following a duly noticed public hearing on September 28, 2022, the Mayor and City Commission hereby adopt the Final Operating Millage rate of 0.9717 mills for the District for FY 2023, which is nine and six tenths percent (9.6%) more than the "Rolled-back" rate of 0.8864 mills.
