SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE FINANCE AND ECONOMIC RESILIENCE COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS FEASIBILITY, LOCATION, AND FUNDING FOR ANOTHER RESIDENTIAL COMPOSTING PROGRAM.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

At the Sustainability Committee on March 31, 2022, the Committee passed a motion urging the City to signal its support to Miami-Dade County for the construction of a commercial composting facility and furthermore, the development of a curbside compost pickup program for residents and businesses.

On May 4, 2022, the Mayor and City Commission referred this discussion to the Land Use and Sustainability Committee.

On September 28, 2022, the Land Use and Sustainability Committee passed a motion to refer a discussion to the Finance and Economic Resilience Committee about the feasibility, location, and funding for another residential composting location.
