Dear Honorable Mayor and City Commission,
The Sustainability Committee met on May 24, 2022 and passed the motions below:

- The Sustainability Committee urges the Mayor and City Commission to explore other communities' experiences and successes with installing storm drain grates, including City of Aventura, and install storm drain grates in areas with high levels of litter and minimal shrubs and trees, such as Washington Ave and Alton Road, that can be regularly maintained.
- In line with its October 28, 2021, motion, the Sustainability Committee recommends that enhancements of Flagler Monument Island prioritize:
- Enriching natural habitat;
- Non-motorized use;
- Improving resident use, with equal access to all city residents; and
- Calming the island.
