SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE FINANCE AND ECONOMIC RESILIENCY COMMITTEE REGARDING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PASSES FOR BOARD AND COMMITTEE MEMBERS.

RECOMMENDATION

For the Committee to consider the feasibility of acquiring transit passes from Miami-Dade County as an option instead of a citywide parking decal to remain consistent with the City's vision of being a less car-centric community.

BACKGROUND/HISTORY

Board and committees serve an important purpose providing valuable feedback and ideas to the City Commission and Administration. Traditionally, the City has provided a citywide parking pass to the members who volunteer their time to serve on boards and committees. Many members have chosen not to own a vehicle and instead utilize public transportation.
