EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS OR AGREEMENTS, AND APPROPRIATE FUNDING RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOLLOWING GRANTS, PROGRAMS, AND AGREEMENTS: 1) NATIONAL FISH AND WILDLIFE FOUNDATION, NATIONAL COASTAL RESILIENCE FUND. IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$125,000; 2) U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, THROUGH THE UNITED WAY OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$75,000; AND 3) FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. **PUBLIC TRANSIT** DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIATE AMOUNT OF \$1.25 MILLION.

WHEREAS, the City Administration requests approval to apply for a grant in the approximate amount of \$1,250,000 from Florida Department of Transportation, Public Transit Service Development Program, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution.
