SUBJECT: REFERRAL TO THE FINANCE AND ECONOMIC RESILIENCY COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS THE

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA AND THE

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY HOMELESS TRUST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000.

#### **BACKGROUND/HISTORY**

At the October 26, 2022 City Commission meeting, the City Commission appropriated \$1 million for the Homeless Trust toward the purchase of certain property located outside of the City of Miami Beach, for the purpose of providing housing assistance to homeless persons. As part of the City Commission's approval of the \$1 million funding request, the Chairman of the Homeless Trust represented that the Homeless Trust would provide the City with fifty-five (55) units for City of Miami Beach referrals of homeless persons, and this commitment would be memorialized in a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City and the Homeless Trust.

The item was subsequently discussed at the November 16, 2022 City Commission meeting. The Administration was instructed to obtain documentation supporting the Homeless Trust's commitment. The Administration is working collaboratively to draft an agreement that incorporates deliverables, performance measures and benchmarks that will measure successful outcomes, such as income growth and housing retention.
