A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE AD VALOREM MILLAGE RATE OF 0.8468 MILLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 FOR THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, WHICH IS ELEVEN AND THREE TENTHS PERCENT (11.3%) MORE THAN THE "ROLLED-BACK" RATE OF 0.7610 MILLS, SUBJECT TO A SECOND PUBLIC HEARING SCHEDULED ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 2023, AT 5:02 P.M.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of providing security services within the Normandy Shores neighborhood area, the Mayor and City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 93-2881 on October 20, 1993, which authorized the creation of the Normandy Shores Local Government Neighborhood Improvement District ("District"); and

WHEREAS, Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, specifies the method by which municipalities may set the operating millage rate and adopt an annual budget for dependent taxing districts; and

WHEREAS, the maximum millage that can be approved for the District by a majority (4/7th) vote is 0.7826 mills, anything beyond this rate, up to 0.8609 mills, requires a two-thirds (5/7th) vote, and a unanimous approval is required to approve a millage rate above 0.8609 mills for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2023, the City Commission, acting as the Board of Directors of the District, adopted Resolution No. 2023-32718 which set the proposed operating millage rate of the District at 0.8468 mills for the purpose of providing security services within the District for FY 2024; and

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2023, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, the City Commission, acting as the Board of Directors of the District, held its first duly noticed public hearing to consider the Tentative Ad Valorem Millage and Tentative Operating Budget for the District for FY 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORMANDY SHORES LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT that, following a duly noticed public hearing on September 13, 2023, the Mayor and City Commission hereby adopts the Tentative Operating Millage rate of 0.8468 mills for the District for FY 2024, which is eleven and three tenths percent (11.3%) more than the "Rolled-back" rate of 0.7610 mills, subject to a second public hearing scheduled on Wednesday, September 27, 2023, at 5:02 p.m., in the Miami Beach Convention Center at 1901 Convention Center Drive, Meeting Rooms 222-225, Miami Beach, Florida 33139.
