**SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE MIAMI BEACH CITY CODE, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION," BY AMENDING ARTICLE III, ENTITLED "AGENCIES, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES," BY AMENDING DIVISION 34, BY CREATING SECTIONS 2-190.149 THROUGH 2-190.152 TO ESTABLISH THE "NEIGHBORHOOD RESILIENCY PROJECTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE," TO ADVISE THE ADMINISTRATION AND CITY COMMISSION IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY'S RESILIENCY PROJECTS IN ORDER TO IMPROVE PLANNING AND DELIVERY OF THESE CRITICAL PROJECTS; AND PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

The attached Ordinance was prepared at the request of Commissioner Laura Dominguez for consideration at the December 13, 2023 City Commission meeting.

On October 13, 2021, the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Miami Beach (the "City") adopted Resolution No. 2021-31898, establishing the Ad Hoc Neighborhood Resiliency Projects Advisory Committee (the "Committee") for a period of one year, to advise the Administration and City Commission in connection with the City's climate resiliency projects in order to improve planning and delivery of these critical projects.

The Committee sunsetted in October 2022, one year after its establishment. In 2022, the Mayor and City Commission re-established the Committee for a period of one year, in order for the Committee to continue advising the City Manager and the Mayor and City Commission on neighborhood and private property matters related to the City's resiliency projects.

The sponsor has proposed the attached Ordinance, to make the Committee a permanent standing advisory board of the City, to allow the Committee to continue to engage residents to build and strengthen the stakeholder and community support and feedback, and to highlight areas of concern in delivering critical resiliency projects.
