Also, the seniors on 5<sup>th</sup> Street used to have a lunchroom at Council Towers South (operated by Little Havana), which is now closed. We also closed the senior lunchroom at the 6<sup>th</sup> Street Community Center.

How can we replace these two senior lunchrooms? I would place a high priority on re-opening at least one senior lunch facility.
