COLLINS CANAL HISTORIC SITE DESIGNATION

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYDR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS OF THE CITY CODE, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE RESULTINCY CODE, ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION AND REVIEW PROCEDURES," ARTICLE WILL, ENTITLED "HISTORIC PRESERVATION," SECTION 2.13.9, ENTITLED "HISTORIC DESIGNATION," AT SUBSECTION (E)(I), ENTITLED "HISTORIC PRESERVATION SITES (HPS)," BY DESIGNATING THE COLLINS CANAL. LOCATED BETWEEN BISCAYVE BAY AND LAKE PANCDAST AS AN HISTORIC SITE TO BE KNOWN AS "COLLINS CANAL." AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING THAT THE CITY'S ZONING MAP SHALL BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE THE COLLINS CANAL. AS AN HISTORIC SITE; ADOPTING THE DESIGNATION REPORT ATTACHED HERETO AS APPENDX "A"; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE LAND DEVELOPMENT RESULATIONS DE THE CITY CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR CDDIFICATION, REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance is being heard pursuant to Chapter 2, Article IV of the RESINGENC CODE. INQUINGS may be directed to the Planning Organization and plant and the Chapter 2, Article IV of the RESING FOR STATUS.
