A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING (AND, AS TO CERTAIN AGREEMENTS, RETROACTIVELY APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING) THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO APPLY FOR, AND ACCEPT FUNDING, EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS OR AGREEMENTS, AND APPROPRIATE FUNDING RECEIVED BY THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH IN CONNECTION WITH THE FOLLOWING GRANTS, PROGRAMS, AND AGREEMENTS: 1) FLORIDA OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT (VOCA), IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$443,900; 2) U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION, FY 2024 LOW OR NO EMISSION GRANT PROGRAM AND THE GRANTS FOR BUSES AND BUS FACILITIES COMPETITIVE PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$17.7 MILLION ; AND 3) U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, THROUGH THE UNITED WAY OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM, IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$100,000.

WHEREAS, the Administration applies for grants and external funding from outside organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Administration requests approval to apply for a grant in the approximate amount of \$443,900 from Florida Office of the Attorney General, Victims of Crime Act (VOCA), the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Administration requests approval to apply for a grant in the approximate amount of \$17.7 million from Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, FY 2024 Low or No Emission Grant Program and the Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities Competitive Program, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Administration requests approval to apply for a grant in the approximate amount of \$100,000 from U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, through The United Way of Miami-Dade County, Emergency Food and Shelter Program, the details of which are set forth in the Commission Memorandum accompanying this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby approve and authorize (and, as to certain agreements, retroactively approve and authorize) the City Manager, or her designee, to apply for, and accept funding, execute any and all documents or agreements, and appropriate funding received by the City of Miami Beach in connection with following grants, programs, and agreements: 1) Florida Office of the Attorney General, Victims Of Crime Act (VOCA), in the approximate amount of \$443,900; 2) Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, FY 2024 Low or No Emission Grant Program and the Grants for Buses and Bus Facilities Competitive Program, in the approximate amount of \$17.7 million; and 3) U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, through the United Way of Miami-Dade County, Emergency Food and Shelter Program, in the approximate amount of \$100,000.
