A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE ADMINISTRATION TO ESTABLISH AN EARLY-STAGE RESIDENT OUTREACH POLICY FOR PROJECTS THAT WILL IMPACT PARKING AND/OR OTHER QUALITY OF LIFE ISSUES, SUBJECT TO REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY THE CITY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, infrastructure projects are necessary for the development and enhancement of the City and resident quality of life, but often result in loss of parking, whether temporary or permanent, and other impacts on residents' daily lives; and

WHEREAS, early consultation with residents during the conceptual design phase of projects can provide crucial insights into actual parking usage and other quality of life considerations; and

WHEREAS, residents possess valuable knowledge about their neighborhoods, including street usage patterns and parking needs, making their input essential for creating effective solutions; and

WHEREAS, early and pro-active collaboration between engineers, contractors, and residents commencing at the conceptual design stages can lead to innovative compromises that address resident concerns while advancing project objectives without delay; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Commission desire to direct the City Administration to establish a policy for initiating an early-stage resident outreach for projects that will impact parking and/or other quality of life issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby direct the Administration to establish an early-stage resident outreach policy for projects that will impact parking and/or other quality of life issues, subject to review and approval by the City Commission.
