A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY NEIGHBORHOODS AND QUALITY OF LIFE COMMITTEE, AT ITS MARCH 20, 2024 MEETING, TO APPROVE BRITANY BAY PARK AS THE PERMANENT LOCATION FOR THE YEAR-ROUND EXHIBITION OF THE WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH PLACARDS RECENTLY DISPLAYED IN THE LUMMUS PARK AREA DURING MARCH OF 2023.

WHEREAS, during the April 28, 2023 Commission meeting, a discussion was referred to the Public Safety and Neighborhood Quality of Life Committee ("PSNQLC") by Commissioner Laura Dominguez to discuss the Miami Beach Commission for Women's recommendation for the City to find a permanent location for the year-round exhibition of the Women's History Month placards recently displayed in the Lummus Park area during March of 2023; and

WHEREAS, during the March 20, 2024 PSNQLC meeting, the Committee approved Britany Bay park as the permanent location for the year-round exhibition of the Women's History Month placards recently displayed in the Lummus Park area during March of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Britany Bay park is a great location as it is a recently renovated waterfront park; and since reopening, the park has experienced an increase in activity; and

WHEREAS, the initial cost for each placard is \$1,800-\$3,000 and the cost to replace the design on each placard is estimated around \$500; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department will be using current operating funds to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the recommended installation method is similar to that of park signs, which allows for ease of replacement as needed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby approve the recommendation of the Public Safety Neighborhoods and Quality of Life Committee, at its March 20, 2024 meeting, to approve Britany Bay Park as the permanent location for the year-round exhibition of the Women's History Month placards displayed in the Lummus Park area during March of 2023.
