This law firm represents 620 Park Central Partners, LLC (the "Applicant") with regard to the above-referenced property (the "Property"). Please let the following serve as the required letter of intent in connection with a request for a Modification to the Certificate of Appropriateness approved through HPB Order No. 7407.

<u>Description of Property</u>. The Property is 6,500 square feet in size, located on the west side of Ocean Drive between 6th Street and 7th Street. To the north of the Property Heathcote Apartment building and to the south is the Beach Paradise Hotel. To the west is Ocean Court, and to the east of the Property lie famous Lummus Park and the beach. The Property is located within the MXE, Mixed Use Entertainment Zoning District, and is also located within the Ocean Drive/ Collins Avenue Historic District. The Property is currently vacant and has been for a number of years.

Description of Development Program. HPB Order No. 7407 approved a new 50 foot, four-story hotel ("HPB Approval"). As the The hotel features a modern design which will uniquely complement Ocean Drive and its existing historic buildings. Further, the hotel will feature only twelve (12) suites which will be suspended above the lobby, restaurant and public areas. The suites will be organized around a four-story central open core, enhanced by a transparent roof terrace pool, which floods the space with light and liveliness.

At this time, the Applicant respectfully requests two modifications to the approved design:

- 1) Retractable awnings to be attached to the front façade of the structure; and
- 2) Modification to Condition C.1.c. of the HPB Approval related to the roof deck and glass railings.

Retractable Awnings. The Applicant is seeking a Certificate of Appropriateness ("COA") for new awnings for the front façade of the new building. The proposed design is preferable to the otherwise approvable jungle of sidewalk umbrellas. The awnings' modern design will require no frontal support, and provide for uninterrupted views for both the public and patrons of the Property. The awnings will have a mechanically operated, retractable canopy that will be usable in all weather conditions. Most importantly, the proposed awnings are in line with the overall vision of the Ocean Drive Task Force, which was put together by the Mayor to rehabilitate the aesthetics of Ocean Drive.

Modification to Condition C.1.c. Condition c of the HPB Approval requires:

"The glass railings at the roof deck shall be setback a minimum of two (2) feet from the exterior side walls up to the eastern face of the proposed stair and planter feature, of the floor immediately below and ten (10) feet from the front projecting balcony façade, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board."

The Applicant's team has carefully studied the approved location of the glass railings and has begun to consider the layout of the pool deck. Condition C.1.c.'s requirement that the glass railings be located ten (10) feet from the projecting balcony façade renders a significant amount of the pool deck unusable, approximately fifteen percent (15%). The useable roof area is relatively small and does not contain much space for sunbathing. The iconic pool, elevator, stairs, and restroom facilities occupy over fifty percent (50%) of the roof top area, no including circulation zones. Accordingly, the Applicant respectfully requests to modify condition C.1.c. to permit the glass railings two (2) feet from the front of the projecting balcony, instead of ten (10), to reclaim some of the roof deck's usable area. It's important to note that there are strict operational conditions imposed by the HPB Approval that the Applicant is not seeking to modify. These conditions, that will remain intact, include: limiting use of the rooftop amenity area to hotel guests and their guests; no live entertainment on the rooftop amenity area; and no special event on the rooftop. The roof deck will be respectably and responsibly operated.

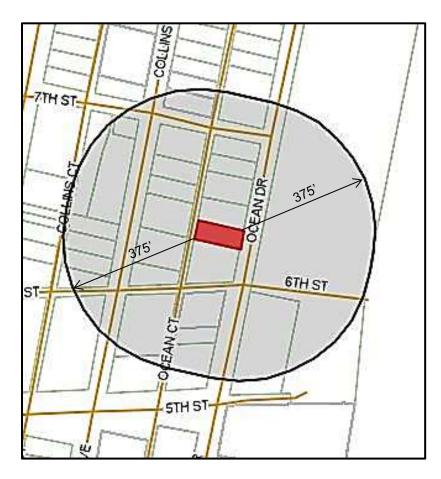

- A. The subject vacant site is located within the Ocean Drive/Collins Avenue Local Historic District.
- B. Based on the plans and documents submitted with the application, testimony and information provided by the applicant, and the reasons set forth in the Planning Department Staff Report, the project as submitted is consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria in Section 118-564(a)(1) of the Miami Beach Code, is consistent with Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria in Section 118-564(a)(2) of the Miami Beach Code, and is not consistent with Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria 'b' & 'g' in Section 118-564(a)(3) of the Miami Beach Code.

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- C. The project would be consistent with the criteria and requirements of section 118-564 if the following conditions are met:
 - 1. Revised elevation, site plan, and floor plan drawings shall be submitted to and approved by staff; at a minimum, such drawings shall incorporate the following:
 - a. The louvered screens shall be fixed at the center location only and may be permitted to be fixed at the location of the easternmost window located on the south and north elevations. The final design and details of the proposed louvered screens shall be provided and shall be integrated into the balcony and roof slabs, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - b. The 2-inch stucco reveals proposed for the upper floors shall be incorporated along the ground level of the south elevation, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - c. The glass railings at the roof deck shall be setback a minimum of two (2) feet from the exterior side walls up to the eastern face of the proposed stair and planter feature, of the floor immediately below and ten (10) feet from the front projecting balcony façade, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - d. Final details of all exterior surface finishes and materials shall be required, including samples, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - e. The final design and details of all exterior lighting shall be provided, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board. Interior lighting shall be designed in a manner to not have an adverse overwhelming impact upon the surrounding historic district.
 - f. The balcony railings consist of clear glass; butt jointed with a minimal stainless steel cap and shall be integrated into the balcony slab, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - g. The final design and details of all railings shall be provided, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
 - h. A copy of all pages of the recorded Final Order shall be scanned into the plans submitted for building permit, and shall be located immediately after the front cover page of the permit plans.
 - 2. A revised landscape plan, prepared by a Professional Landscape Architect, registered in the State of Florida, and corresponding site plan, shall be submitted to and approved by



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staff. The species type, quantity, dimensions, spacing, location and overall height of all plant material shall be clearly delineated and in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the directions from the Board and/or the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria. At a minimum, such plan shall incorporate the following:

- i. Street trees shall be required along Ocean Drive, placed with a minimum 36" clear space between the tree trunk and the back of curb, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
- j. Silva Cells in tree pits, with the City Standard black and white bound aggregate system and fertilization trench, irrigation, and two (2) up-lights per City standards, shall be required for all street and shade trees, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
- k. The utilization of root barriers and/or Silva Cells, as applicable, shall be clearly delineated on the revised landscape plan.
- I. A fully automatic irrigation system with 100% coverage and an automatic rain sensor in order to render the system inoperative in the event of rain. Right-of-way areas shall also be incorporated as part of the irrigation system.
- m. FPL transformers or vault rooms, backflow preventers and all other related devices and fixtures shall not be permitted within any required yard or any area fronting a street or sidewalk. Their location and how they are screened with landscape material from the right-of-way, shall be clearly indicated on the site and landscape plans in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
- 3. The Applicant agrees to the following operational conditions for any and all permitted hotel and accessory uses and shall bind itself, lessees, permittees, concessionaires, renters, guests, users, and successors and assigns and all successors in interest in whole or in part to comply with the following operational and noise attenuation requirements and/or limitations.

a. OPERATIONAL CONDITIONS

- i. Use of the rooftop amenity area shall be limited to hotel guests and their guests.
- ii. There shall be no live entertainment on the rooftop amenity area; all music played on the rooftop shall be limited to ambient background music.
- iii. Special events pursuant to the Miami Beach City Code may not be held on the rooftop amenity area and the applicant agrees that it will not seek or authorize applications for such permits



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- iv. Operation of the rooftop amenity area shall be limited to the between the hours 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m.
- v. In the event Code Compliance receives complaints of unreasonably loud noise from mechanical and/or electrical equipment, and determines the complaints to be valid, even if the equipment is operating pursuant to manufacturer specifications, the applicant shall take such steps to mitigate the noise with noise attenuating materials as reviewed and verified by an acoustic engineer, in a manner to be reviewed and approved by staff consistent with the Certificate of Appropriateness Criteria and/or the directions from the Board.
- 4. Satisfaction of all conditions is required for the Planning Department to give its approval on a Certificate of Occupancy; a Temporary Certificate of Occupancy or Partial Certificate of Occupancy may also be conditionally granted Planning Departmental approval.
- 5. The Final Order shall be recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, <u>prior</u> to the issuance of a Building Permit.
- 6. The Final Order is not severable, and if any provision or condition hereof is held void or unconstitutional in a final decision by a court of competent jurisdiction, the order shall be returned to the Board for reconsideration as to whether the order meets the criteria for approval absent the stricken provision or condition, and/or it is appropriate to modify the remaining conditions or impose new conditions.
- 7. The conditions of approval herein are binding on the applicant, the property's owners, operators, and all successors in interest and assigns.
- 8. Nothing in this order authorizes a violation of the City Code or other applicable law, nor allows a relaxation of any requirement or standard set forth in the City Code.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, based upon the foregoing findings of fact, the evidence, information, testimony and materials presented at the public hearing, which are part of the record for this matter, and the staff report and analysis, which are adopted herein, including the staff recommendations, which were amended by the Board, that the Certificate of Appropriateness is GRANTED for the above-referenced project subject to those certain conditions specified in paragraph C of the Findings of Fact (Condition Nos. 1-8 inclusive) hereof, to which the applicant has agreed.

PROVIDED, the applicant shall build substantially in accordance with the plans approved by the Historic Preservation Board, as determined by staff, entitled "THE SUITES AT THE PARK CENTRAL HOTEL", as prepared by Borges + Associates and space4architecture, dated April 8, 2014.
