AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING "APPENDIX A – FEE SCHEDULE" TO AUTHORIZE THE WAIVER OF DESIGN REVIEW BOARD OR HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD FEES FOR NONPROFITS PROPOSING ART IN PUBLIC PLACES AND/OR NON-COMMERCIAL ARTISTIC MURALS, GRAPHICS AND IMAGES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING "APPENDIX A – FEE SCHEDULE" TO AUTHORIZE THE WAIVER OF DESIGN REVIEW BOARD OR HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD FEES FOR NONPROFITS PROPOSING ART IN PUBLIC PLACES AND/OR NON-COMMERCIAL ARTISTIC MURALS, GRAPHICS AND IMAGES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Beach has the authority to enact laws which promote the public health, safety and general welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City Code of Ordinances contains fees for development review, permitting, and other services to cover the costs of implementing the regulations contained therein; and

WHEREAS, certain nonprofit organizations, (i.e. the Bass Museum, Miami Design Preservation League) desire to invest in public art installments; and

WHEREAS, in order to assist these nonprofits in providing these benefits to the residents and visitors of Miami Beach, the City, desires to waive the fees associated with Design Review Board or Historic Preservation Board review of said art in public places and/or non-commercial artistic murals, graphics and images; and

WHEREAS, the amendments set forth below are necessary to accomplish the above objectives.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. "Appendix A – Fee Schedule", of the Code of the City of Miami Beach is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 3. CODIFICATION.

It is the intention of the City Commission, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code of the City of Miami Beach as amended; that the sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention; and that the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section" or other appropriate word.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten days following adoption.
