Hello Dan, Micky, Mark, Kristen, Ricky and John -

We have lived on Hibiscus for the past 15 years and have never had any flooding issues. Now the street is higher than our home, and we are still discussing potential harmonization solutions with the city, as the entrance to our garage is over a foot lower than the street. We will need a drain installed. We need the drain to have power in a storm. We need the generators that had been allocated to Hibiscus to be installed so we don't have flooding in our home due to the new street height, especially when we have a storm that knocks out the power. We lose power frequently even without a storm!

Please allocate permanent generators for the storm pumps on Hibiscus and Palm Islands.
