I urge you as elected officials to do anything you can do provide us with **PERMANENT generators** as we know that moving/installing and fueling temporary generators in a heavy downpour does not make sense and by the time it is deployed and functional our homes will be flooded.

I have seen that Sunset Harbour area has benefited from the permanent generators and I ask that we be provided with such. We do not want a flooding disaster on our hands. I don't mind a flooded street but I can not have a FLOODED HOME. Please help.
