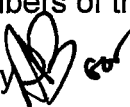

SUBJECT: A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE'S HONORARY DESIGNATION OF BRIDGE NUMBER 870054 ON STATE ROAD 112/W. 41ST STREET/ARTHUR GODFREY ROAD IN MIAMI BEACH AS THE "SENATOR PAUL B. STEINBERG BRIDGE"; AND, URGING THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT") TO TAKE ANY AND ALL ACTIONS, AS REQUIRED, TO EFFECTUATE THE DESIGNATION OF THE BRIDGE AS APPROVED BY AND CONSISTENT WITH FLORIDA SENATE BILL 368.

Senator Paul B. Steinberg is a former member of the Florida Senate and House of Representatives, and is a long-time and distinguished attorney in and resident of the City of Miami Beach. Pursuant to Florida Senate Bill 368, which was passed by the Florida Legislature during the 2017 Legislature session and became effective July 1, 2017, Bridge number 870054 on State Road (S.R.) 112/W. 41st Street/Arthur Godfrey Road in the City of Miami Beach (the "Bridge") was designated as the "Senator Paul B. Steinberg Bridge."

As provided in Section 334.071(2) of the Florida Statutes, the honorary designation of a transportation facility requires the placement of markers by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Pursuant to Section 334.071(3) of the Florida Statutes, the placement of markers by FDOT designating the Bridge is contingent upon the City Commission passing a resolution in support of the honorary designation. Therefore, the attached Resolution is required in order to effectuate the placement of markers by FDOT to designate the Bridge in honor of Senator Paul B. Steinberg.
