SUBJECT: Lincoln Court Pedestrian Bridge

The City of Miami Beach Public Works Department is applying to the Design Review Board, seeking approval for the decorative 'Venetian Bubble' aluminum side panels the permanent ramping, railing and landscaping on the north side of the new pedestrian bridge which would cross Collins Canal from Lincoln Court to Dade Boulevard.

Under direction of the City Commission and in order to improve the general safety of pedestrians, the city plans to construct a pedestrian bridge that will provide connectivity between the West Avenue and Sunset Harbor neighborhoods across the Collins Canal. The bridge design consists of 65 feet span across Collins Canal that will be 8 feet wide made of aluminum railings with bubble design side panels and wood decking being accessed through ADA compliant ramps to the north and south ends of the bridge.

The proposed project will provide improved facilities, as well as, an enhanced experience for the city's residents who will have ease of access to Sunset Harbor's Maurice Gibb Memorial Park as well as local businesses and establishments in both neighborhoods.
