A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE FINANCE AND CITYWIDE PROJECTS COMMITTEE AT ITS JULY 27, 2018 MEETING; AND FOLLOWING A DULY NOTICED PUBLIC HEARING PURSUANT TO SECTION 90-221 OF THE CITY CODE, RAISING THE FRANCHISE FEE PAID TO THE CITY BY ITS FRANCHISE WASTE CONTRACTORS FROM THE CURRENT FEE OF 18%, TO 20%, OF THE FRANCHISEE'S TOTAL MONTHLY GROSS RECEIPTS FOR SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL IN THE CITY, WITH SUCH RAISE TO BECOME EFFECTIVE ON OCTOBER 1, 2018.

**WHEREAS**, under Chapter 90, of the City Code, at Section 90-221, the City Commission may raise its solid waste collection and disposal franchise fee once yearly, with said raises not to exceed two percent (2%); and

**WHEREAS**, such raise may be imposed by Resolution, after a public hearing with 30 days prior notice to all franchise solid waste contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, the last time the City increased solid waste collection and disposal franchise fees occurred 11 years ago, pursuant to Resolution No. 2007-26658, which increased the franchise fee from 16 percent to 18 percent, effective October 1, 2007; and

**WHEREAS**, increasing the franchise fee from 18 percent to 20 percent will generate additional revenue in the Sanitation budget of approximately \$84,000; and

**WHEREAS**, at the July 27, 2018 Finance and Citywide Projects Committee meeting, the Committee recommended increasing the franchise fee from 18% to 20%; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 21, 2018, the City Administration provided the required 30 day notice to all of the City's franchise waste contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Administration requests that the Mayor and City Commission adopt this resolution, after public hearing.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby accept the recommendation of the Finance and Citywide Projects Committee at its July 27, 2018 meeting; and following a duly noticed public hearing pursuant to Section 90-221 of the City Code, raising the franchise fee paid to the City by its franchise waste contractors from the current fee of 18%, to 20%, of the franchisee's total monthly gross receipts for solid waste collection and disposal in the City, with such raise to become effective on October 1, 2018.
