A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, ON BEHALF OF THE MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM THE CITY OF NORTH BAY VILLAGE OF A THREE-YEAR OLD NARCOTICS TRAINED CANINE, WITH AN APPROXIMATE TOTAL VALUE OF \$25,000, FOR USE BY THE MIAMI BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT CANINE UNIT.

WHEREAS, the Miami Beach Police Department has identified a need to acquire an additional narcotics detection canine, which shall be used for narcotics detection and criminal apprehension, in order to prevent, detect and deter those subjects involved in various criminal activities occurring in the City of Miami Beach; and

WHEREAS, specially trained canines have proven to be an effective means to hinder criminal activity, including illegal narcotics activity, and to apprehend those individuals who commit crimes throughout the City of Miami Beach; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bay Village has ownership of a three-year old canine with an approximate value of \$13,000, and such canine has successfully completed a 6-week narcotics training course valued at approximately \$12,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bay Village, on behalf of the North Bay Village Police Department, has graciously offered to donate this canine to the Miami Beach Police Department, as the North Bay Village Police Department no longer desires to keep the canine; and

WHEREAS, the proposed donation will enhance the Miami Beach Police Department Canine Unit and, in doing so, will make the City of Miami Beach a safer place to live, work and play.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT DULY RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that the Mayor and City Commission hereby authorize the City of Miami Beach, on behalf of the Miami Beach Police Department, to accept a donation from the City of North Bay Village of a three-year old narcotics trained canine, with an approximate total value of \$25,000, for use by the Miami Beach Police Department Canine Unit.
